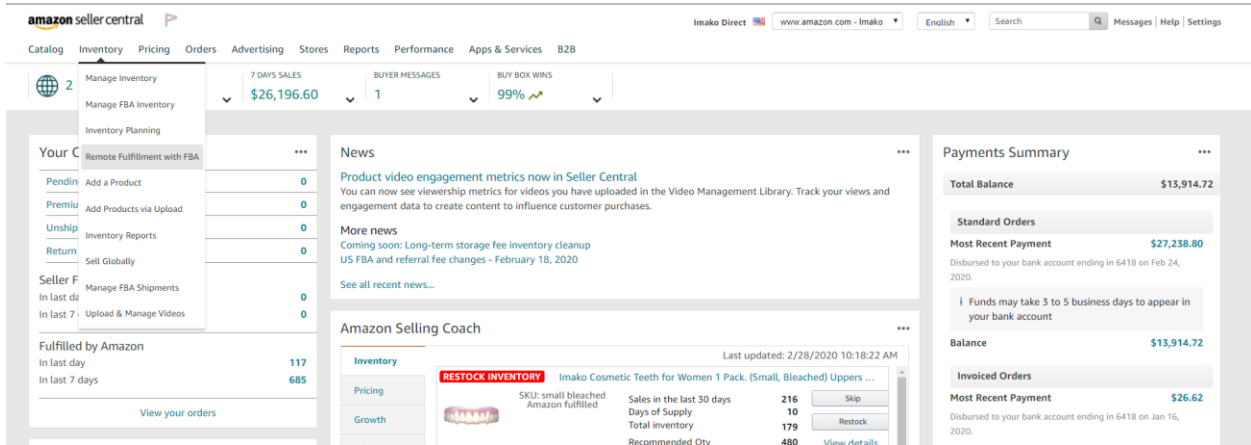
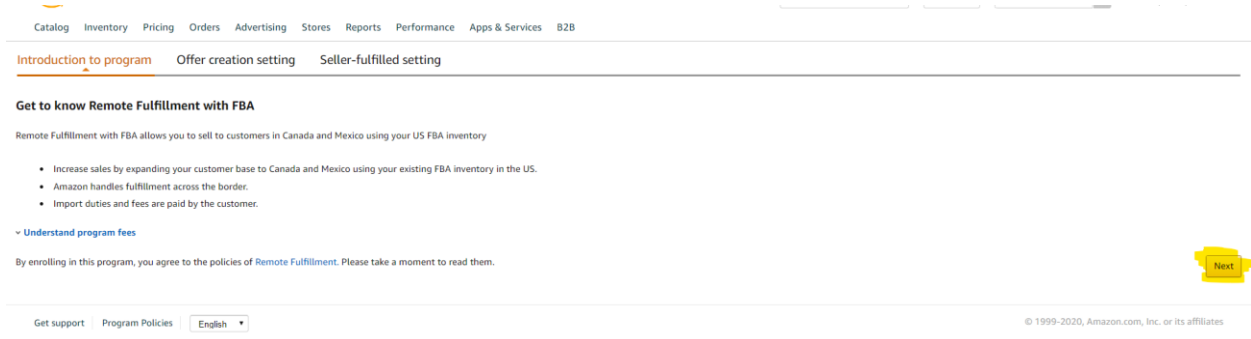


North America Remote Fulfillment (NARF) Enrollment Guide

Step 1: Log in to your US Seller Central account, hover "Inventory" widget and select "Remote Fulfillment with FBA"



Step 2: Understand the program fees and click "Next"



Step 3: Choose your target marketplace (CA) to enable automatic listing creation. If you do not enable automatic listing creation, you must create offers in Canada to make your inventory available for sale.

Customers can't buy your Remote Fulfillment items until a listing exists in their marketplace. Automatic listings creation makes it easy for you to create your US offers in the Canada and Mexico marketplaces.
 If you already have a Build International Listings connection to Canada and Mexico from another marketplace or use Canada or Mexico as a source marketplace, automatic listing creation will not work.

Enable automatic listing creation

When you enable automatic listing creation, you request **Build International Listings** to automatically replicate offers for your products from the US to the Canada and Mexico stores. Your US price is synchronized to Canada and Mexico and adjusted for estimated differences in fulfillment fees and foreign exchange rates.

Automatic listing creation does not take into account costs you may incur when converting proceeds back to USD or differences in referral fees between the US and MX marketplaces. (There is no difference in referral fees between the US and CA marketplaces.)

For ASINs that are sold through FBA in Canada and Mexico but are not enrolled in Remote Fulfillment with FBA -- i.e., in a Canada or Mexico fulfillment center -- your US marketplace price will be used and adjusted to reflect foreign exchange rates. You can set different pricing rules for these items in [Build International Listings](#)

In the US you have a price of \$10 USD, and the currency exchange rate is \$1 USD = \$1.30 CAD. The FBA fulfillment fee in the US is \$1 USD, and the FBA fulfillment fee for Remote Fulfillment is \$2 CAD.

If you don't enable automatic listing creation, you must create offers in Canada and Mexico to make your inventory available for sale.

Step 4: Remove Seller-fulfilled offers on Amazon CA (this does not affect most Sellers) and click "Enroll". Eligible ASINs will automatically go live on Amazon CA

Remove seller-fulfilled offers

If you participate in Remote Fulfillment, any seller-fulfilled offers you have will not be able to share the same SKU as an FBA offer. (This does not affect most sellers.)

While enrolled in the program, you will not be able to add seller-fulfilled offers to FBA SKUs. You can, however, maintain seller-fulfilled offers for the same items using separate SKUs. If you have any existing SKUs with both FBA and seller-fulfilled offers, the seller-fulfilled inventory will be set to zero when you enroll in Remote Fulfillment. To ensure accurate inventory levels in case you want to undo these changes later, Amazon will not reset the inventory amounts on those seller-fulfilled offers to previous levels.

Step 5: Generate and download eligibility report and review instructions to make any change to your offers

This report shows the eligibility of your active US FBA offers, and indicates whether you can make an ASIN eligible. It also allows you to remove ASINs or re-enable ones that you have removed. The report takes up to 24 hours to generate.

To manually enable, disable, or re-enable individual ASINs:

1. Enter **No** for ASINs to be removed and **Yes** next to ASINs to be enabled for each Amazon marketplace in question. Note: Eligible ASINs are enabled automatically unless you have removed them from the program or sent them to Canada or Mexico for FBA.
2. Once the changes are made, upload the edited file below as an Excel document. Uploading might take up to 24 hours.

Note: Upload the file only if you're changing an ASIN's enrollment status.
