The Fair for Life Standard certifies products derived from natural raw materials or materials used in handcraft.

FOOD / COSMETIC / DETERGENTS / HANDICRAFT / TEXTILE / ETC.



## Criteria

Certification requirements apply along the supply chain, from production to final consumer labelling.

Each key actor in the supply chain has relevant and progressive criteria with regards to 7 key commitments.

1. Commit to **FAIRNESS**
2. Respect **HUMAN RIGHTS** and offer **DECENT WORKING CONDITIONS**
3. Respect the **ENVIRONMENT, BIODIVERSITY** and **CLIMATE**
4. Act for **SUSTAINABLE LOCAL DEVELOPMENT**
5. Strengthen **SOUND BUSINESS PARTNERSHIPS**
6. Support producers' and workers' **DEMOCRATIC REPRESENTATION**
7. Enable **INFORMED PURCHASE DECISIONS**

## Process
