



FSC standards are among the most rigorous certification standards in the world

Product Category: In theory, FSC certification can apply to any forest product, including solid and composite wood and panel products (i.e., rough wood, sawn wood, pallets, doors, window frames, trusses, flooring, furniture, tools, instruments, cookware, toys, etc.), pulp & paper products (i.e., beverage cartons, paper towels, toilet paper, tissues, nappies, notebooks, envelopes, magazines, catalogues and wallpaper), forest-based fabrics (i.e., rayon, viscose, modal or lyocell), rubber (i.e., shoes, tyres, condoms, catheters, gloves, etc.), non-timber forest products (i.e., cork, essential oils, medicinal and cosmetic ingredients, nuts, mushrooms, fruits, honey and maple syrup).

Minimum Criteria for CPF Program:

- Products must be FSC Certified, products that are only FSC packaged are not yet eligible and FSC-certified books are yet eligible;
- They must be finished products and carry the FSC Label on the product;
- The products must already be sold on Amazon;
- The final seller on Amazon (not the manufacturer or supplier) must hold a Chain of Custody Certificate (CoC) or a Promotional Licence (PLA).

Process to get FSC-certified:

- Choose an FSC-accredited certification body;
- Submit an application;
- Complete an assessment;
- Receive approval;
- Complete an annual audit.

Cost:

- AAF: Annual administration fee based on forest-based products' revenue;
- Certification Body audit costs: vary based on the chosen certification body.
