

Disclosure Requests for Non-Public Registration Data

Amazon Registry Services, Inc. (“Amazon Registry”) does not collect or maintain registrant information for domain names within the TLDs that it operates. To obtain registrant information for a domain name, Amazon Registry recommends you submit a request directly to the registrar of record for the applicable domain name. You can find the registrar of record using ICANN’s lookup tool (available at <https://lookup.icann.org/en>).

To request that Amazon Registry disclose non-public registration data (a “Disclosure Request”) under ICANN’s Registration Data policy, available at <https://www.icann.org/en/contracted-parties/consensus-policies/registration-data-policy>), please email regdata-request@amazon.com.

Disclosure Requests must include the following information:

1. Identity of the requestor, including:
 - a. Name of requestor
 - b. Email of requestor
 - c. Address of requestor
 - d. Phone number of requestor
 - e. State whether the requestor is an individual or a business entity
 - i. If a business entity, note the type of business entity
 - f. Any Power of Attorney statements or similar statements evidencing authorization to act on the requestor’s behalf, where applicable
2. Domain name for which you are requesting data
3. List of data element values requested
4. Information regarding the legal rights of the requestor to request the data and a specific rationale and basis for the request
5. An affirmation that the request is being made in good faith
6. A statement affirming that you will process lawfully any data element values received in response to this request

Amazon Registry will review your request to confirm that it includes all of the required elements enumerated above. **Amazon Registry will only process and respond to your request if all required elements are included.** If applicable, you will receive a response via email, generally within thirty (30) calendar days.
