

AUDIBLE THEATER @ MINETTA LANE THEATRE
COVID-19 PROTOCOLS
(as of 1/14/22)

Guests to the Minetta Lane Theatre who do not comply with the below protocols will be denied entry or asked to leave the theatre.

DO I NEED TO BE FULLY VACCINATED AND BOOSTED TO ATTEND AUDIBLE THEATER EVENTS @ MINETTA LANE THEATRE?:

Guests will need to be fully vaccinated with an FDA or WHO authorized COVID-19 vaccine in order to attend a show and must show proof of vaccination, and proof of matching identification, at their time of entry into the theatre with their valid ticket. “Fully vaccinated” means the performance date you are attending must be:

- at least 14 days after your second dose of an FDA or WHO authorized two dose COVID-19 vaccine, or
- at least 14 days after your dose of an FDA or WHO authorized single dose COVID-19 vaccine.

Beginning January 18, 2022, Audible Theater will also require proof of a COVID booster shot for all those eligible.

- Those not currently eligible to receive a booster will not be denied entry into the facility if two (2) weeks have passed since their second dose in a two-dose vaccine series or two weeks after receiving a single-dose vaccine. Once a person does become eligible, the booster will then be required for access.
- For those that have recently become eligible after January 18, we will allow a two-week grace period for access to the facility. After the two weeks have passed, entry will not be allowed until the booster has been received. Recipients of the Pfizer (age 16+) or Moderna (age 18+) vaccines become eligible for a booster six months after their second dose, and recipients of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine become eligible two months after their single dose.
- Vaccines are now available for children ages 5–11, and completely vaccinated children are welcome at the Minetta Lane Theatre two weeks after they have received their final dose. Photo ID for children under 16 will not be required as long as they are accompanied by parents/guardians with valid photo I.D.
- Negative COVID tests for anyone, including children, **will not be** accepted as an alternative to proof of vaccination. Audible Theater has also ended the additional negative COVID test requirement as of January 18, 2022, when this new policy goes into effect.
- Everyone must provide in-person proof of vaccination and booster (beginning January 18) prior to entering the facility.

The only exception to the above will be for those with medical documentation who are approved for a reasonable accommodation due to a medical condition that prohibits them from receiving a COVID-19 vaccine. Guests requesting an exemption must disclose that they need reasonable accommodation per the above and provide proof of at least one of the following, in addition to properly wearing a mask inside the building:

- negative COVID-19 PCR test taken within 72 hours of the performance, or
- negative COVID-19 rapid antigen test taken within 6 hours of the performance. In each case, the test results must clearly show the date and time of the test.

Through January 17, 2022, guests between the ages of 5 to 11 must show proof that they have received at least one dose of an FDA or WHO authorized COVID-19 vaccine. Starting January 18, 2022, children ages 5 to 11 need to be fully vaccinated.

Guests may present proof of vaccination or a negative test on paper or a smartphone. For example, New York State residents, or anyone who received a COVID-19 vaccine in New York State, may present proof through the use of the [Excelsior Pass](#).

WILL I NEED A PHOTO ID?

In addition to proof of vaccination, all guests 18 years or older must also present a government-issued photo ID, such as a driver's license or passport. Guests under 12 must be accompanied by an adult who meets the above requirements. Guests under the age of 18 who are not accompanied by an adult must also present a government-issued photo ID showing proof of age, and may use a school ID for this purpose.

WHAT IS AUDIBLE THEATER @ MINETTA LANE THEATRE'S MASK POLICY:

Everyone in the theatre must wear acceptable face coverings at all times, including during the show, except while actively eating or drinking when seated. All face coverings must cover the nose and mouth and comply with the [CDC guidelines for acceptable face coverings](#).

IS SEATING AT THE MINETTA LANE THEATRE SOCIALLY DISTANT?

Seating for any Audible Theater at the Minetta Lane Theatre event is not socially distant, except that there will be at least six (6) feet between audience members and the performers.

WHAT OTHER COVID PROTOCOLS WILL BE IN PLACE?

- Contactless options will be available for transactions upon entry and for in-venue purchases.
- All auditorium ventilation systems have been upgraded to MERV 13 filters.

- EPA approved cleaning products are used along with rigorous cleaning and sanitation protocols that satisfy the CDC and the New York State Department of Health requirements.
- Easy access to handwashing facilities and hand sanitation for audience members.
- A distance of at least 6 ft. will be maintained between employees and patrons at all times, when feasible.
- By virtue of entering the theatre, guests are acknowledging that all of the statements below are true the day they visit the theatre. If any of the statements are NOT true, guest should not come to the theatre and instead use the exchange and refund policy to re-schedule or refund their tickets.
 - I have not tested positive for COVID-19 through a diagnostic test in the past ten (10) days.
 - I am not and have not recently experienced (within the last 48 hours) any new or worsening symptoms of COVID-19.
 - I have not had close contact or proximate contact with any person(s) confirmed with a diagnostic test or suspected based on symptoms, to have COVID-19 within the past ten (10) days.
- Patrons must comply with any federal, state, or local guidelines in existence at the time of the production. If contact tracing is required under any such guidance, each patron is required to provide contact information before or immediately upon arrival to the event. The contact information must include their full name, date of birth, address, and phone number or e-mail for use in potential contact tracing efforts.

These terms and conditions relate to an individual's use of a ticket to gain admittance to the Minetta Lane Theatre and possible exposure to the novel coronavirus SARS- CoV-2 and any resulting disease (together with any mutation, adaptation, or variation thereof, "COVID-19"):

COVID-19 IS A HIGHLY CONTAGIOUS DISEASE THAT CAN LEAD TO SEVERE ILLNESS AND DEATH. BY VISITING OR ENTERING THE VENUE, YOU ASSUME ALL RISKS, HAZARDS, AND DANGERS INCIDENTAL TO THE EVENT FOR WHICH THE TICKET IS ISSUED. YOU VOLUNTARILY WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS AND POTENTIAL CLAIMS AGAINST EACH OF LIBERTY THEATERS, LLC, AO MEDIA, LLC, EVENT PARTICIPANTS, AND PERFORMERS, AND EACH OF THEIR RESPECTIVE EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, AFFILIATES, OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, OWNERS, VENDORS AND CONTRACTORS, THAT ARISE FROM OR RELATE IN ANY WAY TO, HOWEVER CAUSED, THE RISK OF CONTRACTING OR THE ACTUAL OR ALLEGED CONTRACTING OF COVID-19, OR THAT ARISE FROM OR RELATE IN ANY WAY TO, HOWEVER CAUSED, THE RISK OF EXPOSURE OR ACTUAL OR ALLEGED EXPOSURE TO A BACTERIA, VIRUS OR OTHER PATHOGEN CAPABLE OF CAUSING COVID-19, IN EACH CASE WHETHER THE ACTUAL OR ALLEGED CIRCUMSTANCES GIVING RISE TO ANY CLAIM OCCUR BEFORE, DURING, OR AFTER THE EVENT.
