



# Alexa Built-in Quick Start Guide for Jaguar

When you activate Alexa Built-in voice technology in your Jaguar vehicle, you can ask to play music, listen to audio books, hear the news, check the weather, control smart home devices, get directions, find parking, and more — all with your voice, and all while you keep your hands on the wheel and eyes on the road. The more you talk to Alexa, the more she adapts to your personal speech patterns, vocabulary, and preferences.



## Start using Alexa in your Jaguar

You will need a smartphone, internet connection, and the login details for your Amazon account. Once set up, users can use the voice controls in their vehicle to activate Amazon Alexa content using their multimedia dashboard display and the voice recognition system in their vehicle.

- 1 In your Jaguar: Open the app drawer and go to Accounts > Add Profile and create a profile by entering your name, then click "Next".
- 2 Now, sign-in to your InControl account or if you do not have an account yet set up one. Following that press "Continue". Next, you will be asked to pair your phone. You can skip this step for now and do it later on.
- 3 In your Jaguar: Open the app drawer again, select Alexa and press "Get started". Connect with Alexa either per QR code or by mail. QR code: Scan the QR code with your smartphone, open and follow the link and sign in to your Amazon account. After signing in, when Amazon asks to Share Location please press "Allow".
- 4 Once you signed-in to your Amazon account, the head unit in your Jaguar will ask you to select your preferred Alexa language. Choose the language you want to go further and press "Confirm".
- 5 When signed-in, simply say "Alexa, what is the weather forecast for tomorrow?", or press the "Alexa icon" in the side bar and say "what is the weather forecast for tomorrow?".

- PIVI software version

### How to disconnect Alexa Voice Services in your Jaguar

- I) Go to App Drawer > Connect Accounts > Connected > Alexa and click "Disconnect"
- II) From Alexa smartphone app > Devices > Jaguar > Deregister
