Comprehensive and updated criteria

Criteria covers both environmental and social responsibility in the supply chain and throughout the product life cycle. Criteria areas include hazardous substances, circularity, socially responsible manufacturing, environmentally responsible manufacturing, and much more. To ensure fair competition in procurements, all criteria are mandatory, tough, and independently verified.

Certification process

1. Sign a license agreement with TCO Development, the organization behind TCO Certified.
2. Contact [independent verifiers](#) for product testing and factory assessments.
3. If all criteria are met, the verifier uploads the application to TCO Development's application portal.
4. TCO Development reviews the application for accuracy and — if all criteria are met — issues a certificate. Certified products are listed at our [Product Finder](#).
