# Tips & Reminders

## 2025 High-Traffic and Seasonal Events

Although we highly recommend running promotions strategically throughout the year based on your goals, this is a friendly reminder to review the deals recommendations in your **Advertising** section under the [Deals](#) tab.

For high-traffic events, you will see deal recommendations for each eligible event in your Seller Central Account. We recommend checking these opportunities on a weekly basis.

### **Key Recommendations:**

1. Take advantage of opportunities when you see them available in Seller Central, as they may not be available the following week.
2. Prioritize “Best Deals” when available.
3. Select ASINs that best fit with the season and/or event you want to create deals for.
4. Ensure sufficient inventory is available by the time of the event.

Don't worry if you don't have deals recommendations – you can still create Coupons, Price Discounts, and other promotion types to drive traffic to your listings and enhance customers' experiences.

Get started on creating exciting, can't-miss offers for your customers. These events are your chance to showcase your fantastic handmade creations to the world. Take time to strategize enticing deals to make every season your most successful yet!

This year Easter is **April 20th**, and our marketing will begin ~8 weeks prior to the event. This year's Big Spring Sale will run from **March 25th 00:00 to March 31st 23:59**. We recommend you submit deals by **March 17th** to be considered for the event.

Big Spring Sale will focus on deals from categories including Home, Fashion, Beauty, Outdoors, Sports, and other seasonally relevant categories. The event will have a dedicated landing page and will be promoted through merchandising placements across Amazon.com, email, and push notifications.

## Boost Your Product Visibility

Are you making the most of product attributes in your Handmade listings? These powerful tools have become even more crucial with the New Listing Experience (see section above), helping your creations reach the right customers.

### What are Listing Attributes?

Think of attributes as your product's essential characteristics – like Material, Size, and Metal Type. They're specific to each Product Type (such as Necklaces, Towels, or Candles) and help customers make informed purchasing decisions. To create a new product listing on Amazon, you will use the standard Amazon listing experience with a new **“Handmade Classification”** attribute (see New Listing Experience section for more information.)

### Why Attributes Matter:

- Enhance product discoverability in Amazon searches
- Power automatic browse navigation
- Improve customers' shopping experiences by making it easier for customers to find, evaluate, and purchase your products
- Enable product comparison features
- Populate technical specifications on Detail Pages to help customers make an informed purchasing decision

### Pro Tips for Using Attributes:

1. When creating a [new listing](#), you will enter the item name and select the Product Type the item belongs to. After selecting your Product Type, attributes will automatically appear in your listing page.
2. Access all available attributes through the left-hand menu under "Attributes" → "All attributes."
3. Look for required attributes marked with asterisks and red borders.

4. Watch for red exclamation points indicating sections needing attention.

## Missing Attributes = Missing Opportunities

**Remember:** Products missing relevant attributes won't appear in many of Amazon's discovery features, potentially limiting your reach to customers.

## Quick Reminder: Handmade Customization Requirements

A friendly reminder about your Handmade listings' customization requirements:

### Things to Know:

- Each custom listing must have at least one \$0 (zero-cost) customization option, meaning that customers can use at least one customization feature without paying an additional charge beyond the base price.
- Customers must be required to select at least one customization. Listings that

have only optional text and number customizations must be updated.

- Non-compliant custom Handmade listings could be removed.

**Quick Action Steps:**

1. In your Seller Central account, go to Menu, then click “Inventory”, and select [“Manage All Inventory.”](#)
2. Select "Add/edit customization information" from Edit menu.
3. Review your custom Handmade listings and ensure that each listing includes at least one \$0 (zero-cost) customization option.
