

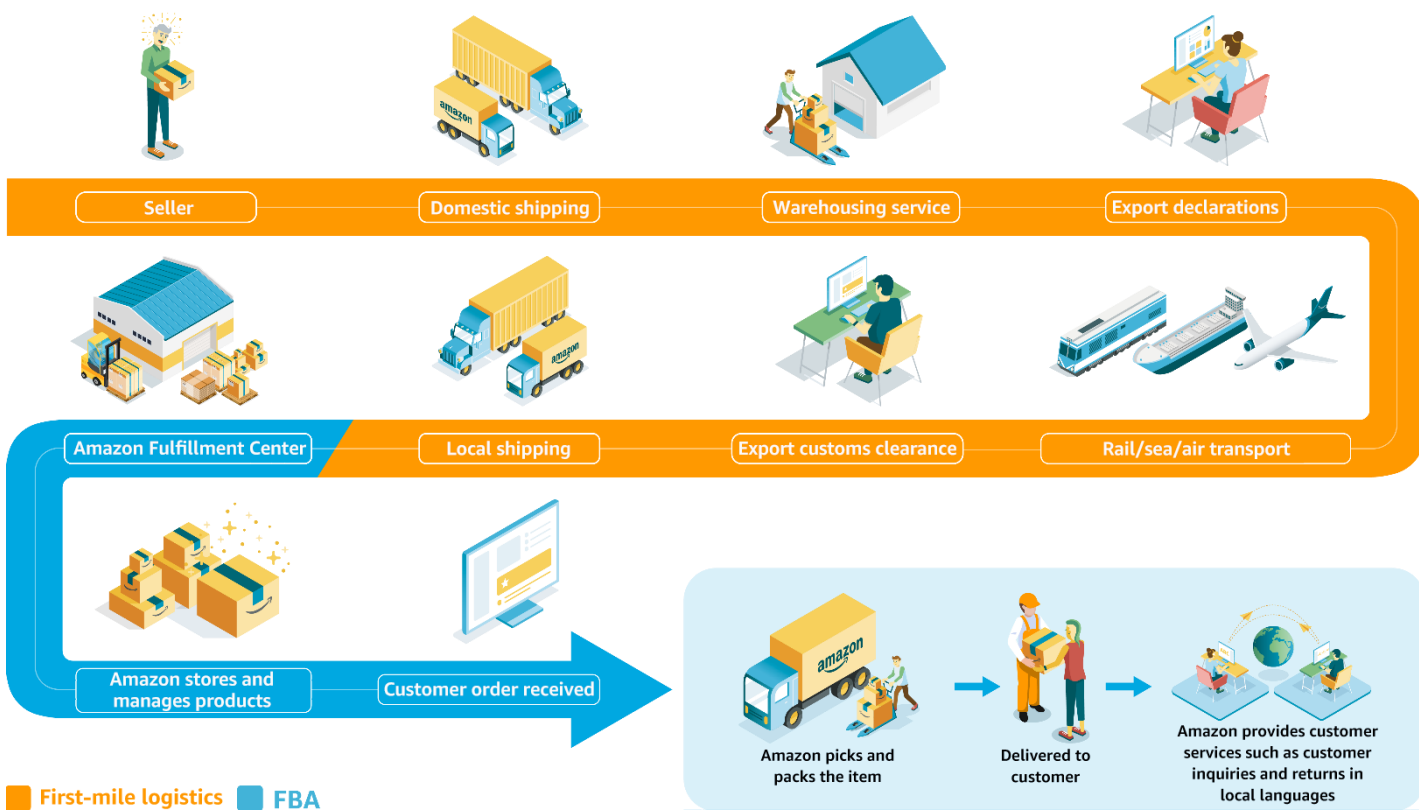

2.1 An introduction to FBA concepts

2.1.1 An introduction to FBA concepts

Fulfillment by Amazon (FBA) is a service whereby you send inventory in batches to an Amazon fulfillment center, then Amazon handles storage. In addition, after a customer places an order, Amazon handles picking, packaging, and delivery while also providing customer service, including customer inquiries and returns for these goods to help you save on manpower and resources. If you are a seller in southeast Asia, this means you can ship your products to an overseas Amazon warehouse, then Amazon will handle subsequent shipping and after-sales service.



Basically, FBA is not only a great choice as a logistics solution for your new cross-border business, but it can also help you attract more Amazon customers from around the world.

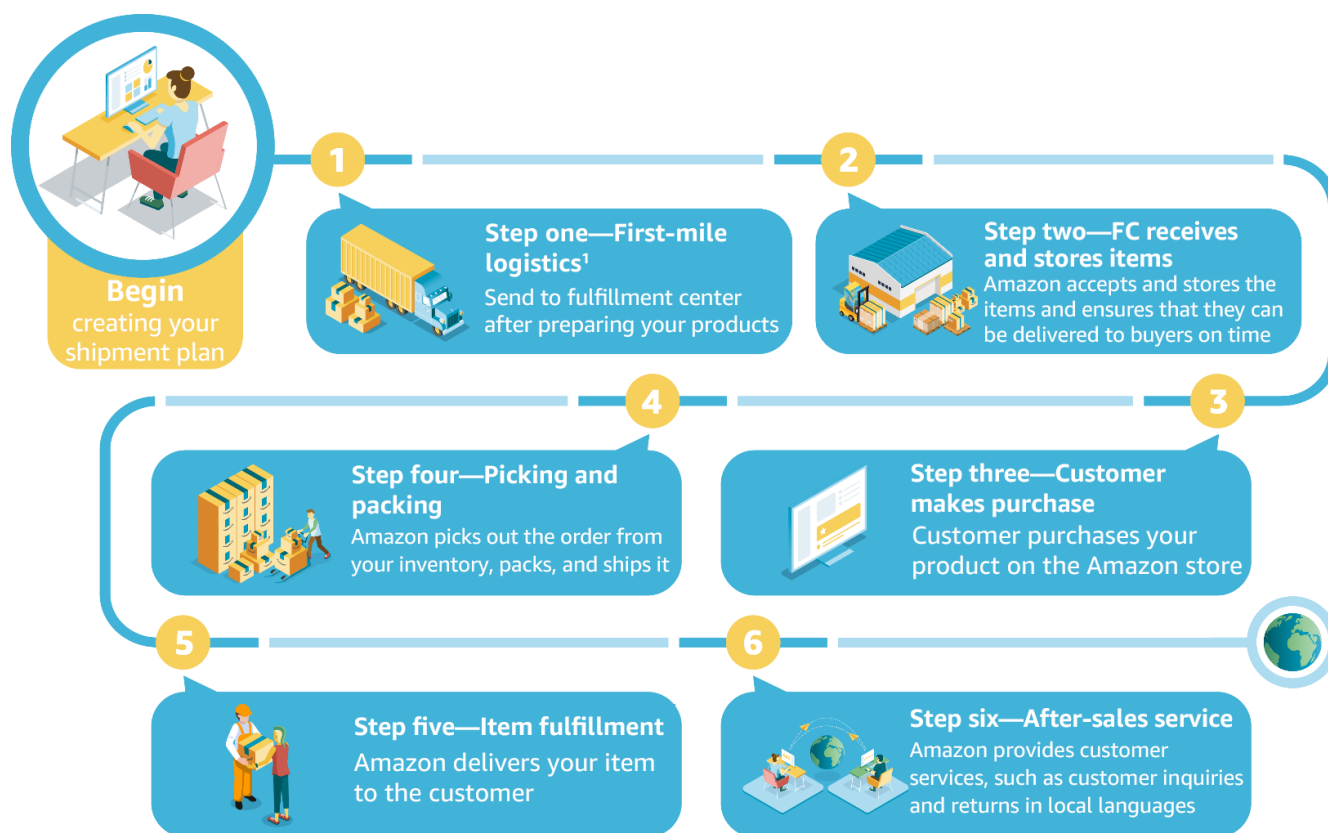
2.1.2 Where is FBA offered

Amazon's top 18 overseas stores for sellers cover more than 300 million active users, 185 fulfillment centers, and support shipping to more than 200 countries and regions. Building on this, FBA can be extensively utilized in regions like North America, Europe, and Japan.



2.1.3 How FBA works

Now that you understand the basic concepts and scope of what Fulfillment by Amazon (FBA) does, the next step is to introduce you to how FBA works:



1. First-mile logistics — Transporting goods from one country to another by land, sea, or air is called first-mile logistics and is one of the steps involved in cross-border fulfillment.

2.2 An overview of the benefits of FBA

Next we'll see the many ways that using FBA can benefit you.

2.2.1 What are the benefits of FBA?



Benefit 1 — High quality traffic conversion from 200 million Prime members

Data show sellers using FBA received a 20–25% lift in sales on average. Products delivered using FBA have the Prime badge, making it easier to reach Amazon's more than 200 million worldwide Prime members, which helps increase visibility and sales.

FBA helps increase customer satisfaction with products, leading to more sales opportunities and higher repeat purchase rates.



Benefit 2 — Fast order fulfillment, as quick as Same-Day Delivery

In 2023, FBA provided Prime members with the fastest delivery speed ever, with same-day or one-day delivery of over 7 billion items. FBA costs on average 70% less than other one-day delivery services in the US.

Eligible products can use Amazon Prime same-day or one-day delivery to help increase your shipping speed and improve the customer experience.

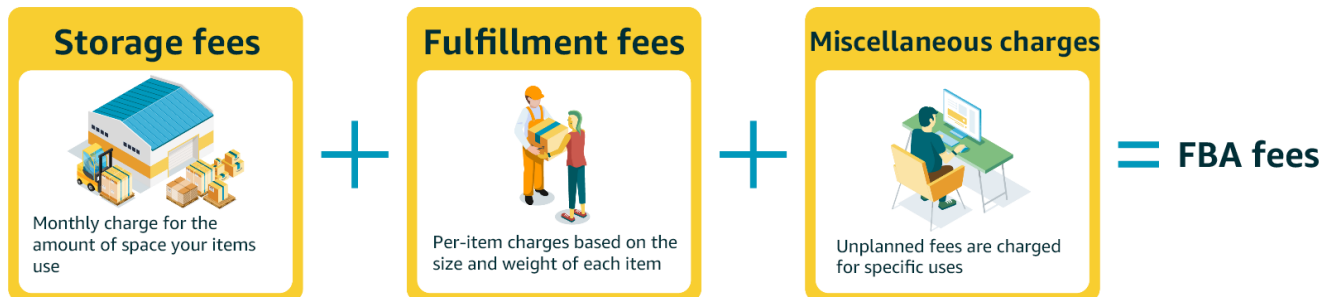


Benefit 3 — Efficient after-sales service with 24×7 customer service in the local language

- **After-sales service** — Amazon uses a network of customer service specialists in more than 130 locations around the world to provide 24×7 local language support via chat, phone, or email to help sellers respond to customer inquiries.
- **Returns and refunds** — When a return occurs, Amazon Fulfillment (FBA) will manage the product return for you, saving you time and making operations easier and more efficient.

2.3 FBA pricing

Amazon charges basic storage and fulfillment fees for each item. Below is a detailed explanation of the storage and fulfillment fees Amazon charges FBA sellers in the US, Europe, and Japan.



1. Storage fees



Storage fees are charged based on the daily average volume of space your inventory takes up in the fulfillment center (in cubic feet).

- **Monthly storage fees**

Amazon charges monthly storage fees for the space that your inventory occupies in fulfillment centers. Monthly storage fees are calculated on your daily average volume in **cubic feet**, based on the size of a unit that is properly packaged and ready to ship in accordance with [FBA policies and requirements](#). Charges vary based on product size tier and time of year.

- **Storage utilization surcharge**

Some sellers are also subject to a storage utilization surcharge in addition to the base monthly storage fee. The surcharge is calculated based on storage utilization ratio, which is the ratio of your average daily inventory volume stored divided by the average daily shipped volume during the past 13 weeks.

- **Aged inventory surcharge**

Amazon charges an aged inventory surcharge (previously known as a long-term storage fee) for inventory items that have been stored in the FBA network for 181 days or more. Starting February 15, 2024, there was a change in the aged inventory surcharge for inventory between 271 and 365 days old. The surcharge will remain the same for inventory between 181 and 270 days old and inventory older than 365 days.

Note that in addition to storage fees—that is, costs incurred after products enter the warehouse—some Amazon stores, like the US, may also impose inbound costs, such as [inbound placement service fees](#). Check the details for each store below.

2. Fulfillment fees



- **FBA fulfillment fees**

FBA fulfillment fees are charged per unit based on the size and weight of the product. First, we determine the size tier of the product (standard or oversized). Using the table below, check the product's fulfillment fees based on the size tier and product weight. Or, refer to the Seller Central [Help](#) for more details.

- **Low-Price FBA rates**

For items whose price is less than a certain amount, you will automatically enjoy Low-Price FBA rates, and the shipping speed is the same as standard FBA. The Low-Price FBA rate is **\$0.77** lower than the standard FBA fee. The standard for what constitutes a low price varies from region to region, so check the information below for the specifics.

- **Fulfillment fees for dangerous goods**

Fulfillment of some dangerous goods, such as products containing lithium batteries, requires additional charges. The lithium battery fee applies to all products that are lithium batteries, contain lithium batteries, or are sold with lithium batteries.

- **Low-inventory-level fees**

If your inventory level is too low, Amazon is unable to distribute products across the US in advance, which affects distribution capacity, reduces the shipping speed, and increases fulfillment costs. Note that a low-inventory-level fee will only apply if a product's inventory level relative to historical demand (known as "historical days of supply") is below 28 days. We will only charge a low-inventory-level fee when both the long-term historical days of supply (last 90 days) and short-term historical days of supply (last 30 days) are below 28 days (4 weeks). Therefore, we encourage you to maintain inventory levels sufficient for 28 days.

The low-inventory-level fee will be waived in the following cases:

1. New professional selling accounts are exempt from this fee for the first 365 days after their initial inventory is received
2. New parent ASINs are exempt from this fee for 180 days after their initial inventory is received, but the seller must be enrolled in FBA New Selection
3. This fee is waived for products that use Amazon's automatic replenishment

3. Other costs

In addition to the basic fees, other actions you take while using FBA may incur additional costs such as charges related to removal or disposal orders and returns processing fees as well as fees for optional paid services such as pre-processing.

2.3.1 Charges in the US

US storage fees



- **Base monthly storage fee and storage utilization surcharge**

To determine which rate applies to your product, do the following:

1. Determine if the product is classified as dangerous goods using the [look up an ASIN](#) tool.
2. Most products will use the first two rates below. If your products are considered dangerous goods, see the dangerous goods product rates.

US fulfillment fees



• Product size tier

Product size tiers are measurement categories based on the unit weight, product dimensions, and dimensional weight of a packaged item. FBA fulfillment fees are charged per unit based on the size and weight of the product. First, we determine the size tier of the product¹ (standard or oversized). Refer to [Product size tiers](#) for more details.

Tips

- **What are dangerous goods?**

Dangerous goods (also known as dangerous items or hazmat) are substances or materials that may pose a risk to health, safety, property, or the environment during storage, handling, or transportation because they contain flammable, pressurized, corrosive, or otherwise harmful substances.

- **Under what circumstances can dangerous goods be shipped?**

Before sending FBA listed products, it's important to know what is suitable for the FBA process and what is not. Carefully read [FBA product restrictions](#) to find out if your products meet Fulfillment by Amazon (FBA) rules or what requirements or steps you need to complete to make your products compliant.

US inbound placement service fees



When creating a shipping plan, you can sign up for the inventory placement service and send all eligible inventory to the same shipping center or fulfillment center. During this process, Amazon will assist in splitting your shipments and reallocating them across multiple warehouses in different regions. The resulting charges are referred to as the "Inbound Placement Service Fee." The inbound placement service fee will depend on the different inbound options selected, specifically, shipping to how many warehouses, and characteristics of the shipment itself, such as product size, weight, quantity, and location.

You'll be charged the FBA inbound placement service fee 45 days after your shipment is received, based on the quantities received.

US inbound defect fees



Amazon may refuse shipments that don't comply with FBA shipment requirements. If we accept inventory that does not meet our shipment requirements or differs from your shipping plan, you may be charged inbound defect fees for the additional cost required to re-direct, receive, and process your shipment. Amazon will charge this fee 45 days after your shipment is received.

Inbound defect fees may be incurred for the following problems:

- **Shipments delivered to the wrong location** — Your shipment was sent to a different fulfillment center than the one listed in your shipping plan.
- **Deleted and abandoned shipments** — Your domestic shipments didn't arrive within 45 days of shipment creation and your international shipments didn't arrive within **75 days** of shipment creation. In a multiple destination shipping plan, your additional shipments didn't **arrive within 30 days of the first shipment arrival**

2.3.2 Charges in Europe

Storage fees

Storage fees are charged based on the daily average volume of space your inventory takes up in the fulfillment center (in cubic feet). Inventory storage fees are generally charged on a monthly basis. Amazon charges an additional aged inventory surcharge for products that have been stored in a fulfillment center for over 365 days.

- **Monthly storage fees**

Amazon charges monthly storage fees for the space that your inventory occupies in fulfillment centers. In Europe starting March 1, 2024, the monthly storage fee for oversized items and clothing, shoes, and luggage will increase from January to September. The monthly storage fee for all products except dangerous goods will also be increased from October to December. This adjustment will be reflected in the March 2024 storage fee charged in April 2024.

• **Storage utilization surcharge**

Starting from June 1, 2024 in Europe, Amazon will introduce more granular fee tiers for storage utilization surcharges and will begin collecting this charge from professional sellers whose storage utilization ratio exceeds 22 weeks. 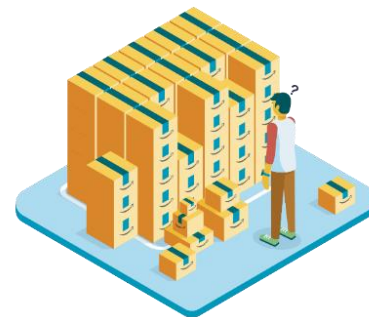

5. For products containing or sold with lithium batteries and dangerous goods, a fee of £0.10, €0.10, SEK 1.00, or PLN 0.40 will be added to each item to cover the additional costs of handling these products.

• Pan-EU program FBA oversize surcharge changes

All oversize items shipped with the Pan-European FBA Program to France, Italy, or Spain currently require a surcharge in addition to local fulfillment fee.

As of July 1, 2024, Amazon will no longer charge this surcharge for oversize items when the region of receipt is the same as the region of sale. The following changes will be made:

1. Amazon limits the current Pan-EU program fulfillment surcharges for items that are inbounded in one region and sold in another region.
2. Amazon will update current Pan-EU program fulfillment fees for oversize items.
3. Amazon will begin charging a Pan-EU program fulfillment surcharge for items fulfilled in Germany.



• Low-Price FBA

Amazon will keep the same Low-Price FBA fulfillment rates in the Germany, France, Italy, Spain, Poland but adjust the Low-Price FBA fulfillment rates in the UK, the Netherlands, and Sweden. Starting September 1, 2024, Amazon will introduce to Belgium Low-Price FBA rates for all products whose price does not exceed €12 (VAT included).

The price threshold will remain the same. This means that products with prices up to £10 in the UK, €11 in Germany, €12 in France, Italy, Spain, and the Netherlands, SEK 140 in Sweden, and PLN 55 in Poland will still automatically be charged Low-Price FBA rates. For Amazon Prime customers, products participating in the Low-Price FBA rates enjoy free shipping, while for non-Amazon Prime customers enjoy standard shipping. - **Low-inventory cost coverage fee (Pan-EU)**

Starting April 1, 2024, Amazon will charge a low-inventory cost coverage fee for standard-size Pan-European FBA products when a product's historical inventory level falls below 28 days. When a seller's historical inventory level is low, Amazon is unable to optimally distribute products across its delivery network, degrading delivery speed and increasing shipping costs.

A low-inventory cost coverage fee will only apply if a product's historical inventory level relative to historical demand (known as "historical days of supply") is below 28 days. We will only charge a low-inventory cost coverage fee when both the long-term historical days of supply (last 90 days) and short-term historical days of supply (last 30 days) are below 28 days. For example, if a product has a short-term historical supply period of more than 28 days, but less than 28 days of long-term historical availability, the low-inventory cost coverage fee (Pan-EU) will not be charged.

We calculate historical days of supply metrics for seller FNSKUs and add the low-inventory cost coverage fee to the Pan-EU program shipping fees for all eligible shipped products in Germany, France, Italy, and Spain.

The low-inventory cost coverage fee (Pan-EU) does not apply to the following products:

1. Oversize items
2. Professional sellers newly enrolled in the Pan-EU program (the first 365 days after enrollment)
3. FNSKUs newly enrolled in the Pan-EU program (the first 180 days after enrollment) You must be enrolled in FBA New Selection to get this benefit. For more information, including seller and product eligibility, go to [FBA New Selection program](#).
4. Pan-EU FNSKUs whose sellers have shipped less than five items per week on average in Germany, France, Italy, and Spain in the past 30 days

- **Calculate the shipping weight**

Amazon uses the greater of unit weight or dimensional weight to calculate the shipping weight, and related fees, for all size tiers for packages and oversized items, except for special oversized items and units receiving Low-Price FBA rates. 2.3.3 Charges in Japan

- **Japan**

- **storage fee**

Storage fees are charged based on the daily average volume of space your inventory takes up in the fulfillment center (in cubic meters). Amazon reserves the right to calculate the volume (in cubic meters) or weight of all packaged products or representative samples using its own measurement methods. In the event of any conflict between an Amazon measurement and information provided by the seller, Amazon's measurement will govern.

- **Monthly storage fees**

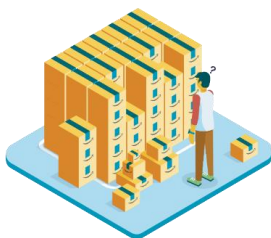
Amazon generally charges the previous month's inventory storage fees between the 7th and 15th of the following month. For example, to view inventory storage fees for January, see the February payments report with transaction information from the seventh to the fifteenth.

- **Aged inventory surcharge**

On the 15th of every month, FBA performs an inventory cleanup. On the same day, Amazon will charge an aged inventory surcharge (including 10% consumption tax) of ¥17.773 per cubic decimeter (10 cm × 10 cm × 10 cm) for products that have been stored in a Japanese fulfillment center for more than 365 days.

- **How to identify inventory subject to fees**

To better manage your inventory and avoid additional fees, Amazon recommends that you review the [Recommended Removal Report](#) and [Inventory Health Report](#) to determine which of your inventory may be subject to aged inventory surcharges.



- **Fulfillment fees**

FBA fulfillment fees are charged per unit based on the size and weight of the product. First, determine the [product size tier](#) (small, standard, large, or extra-large). Once you know the product's size tier, calculate the shipping weight

2.3.4 Other FBA fees

In addition to the basic fees, other actions you take while using Fulfillment by Amazon (FBA) may incur additional costs. Before you take specific action, you should understand what actions may increase operating costs. In this section, Amazon will introduce three common additional costs.



- **Removal, disposal, and liquidation fees**
Removal and disposal fees are charged per item removed or disposed of. Typically, removal orders are processed in 14 business days. However, order processing may take 30 business days or more during the holiday season and peak removal periods.

Instead of paying to remove or dispose of excess or customer-returned FBA inventory, you can choose to use **FBA Liquidations** to have the inventory liquidated through a liquidator. Amazon will apply two separate fees to each item you **liquidate**:

- **The liquidations processing fee** is per item and based on item size and weight.
- **The liquidations referral fee** is 15% and calculated on the gross recovery value.

- **Returns processing fees**

Your product's return rate is the percent of shipped units in a given month that are returned by customers over that month and the subsequent two calendar months. For example, for units shipped in June 2024, the return rate is the percentage of those units returned over June, July, and August 2024. For a given month, the returns processing fee applies to each returned unit above the product category's return-rate threshold. You'll see the charge between the 7th to 15th day of the third subsequent month. For example, for units shipped in June 2024, Amazon will charge the return rate for returned units between September 7 and 15, 2024.

To reflect the costs of processing returns and to reduce waste, **Amazon is expanding the scope of the returns processing fee to include high-return-rate products in all categories (except for clothing and shoes)**. This fee is used to address the operational costs of returns and to reduce waste. The returns processing fee will only apply to items with the highest return rates in each category. The existing average level of returns processing fees for clothing and shoes will remain unchanged.

- **Refund administration fee**

If you refund a customer order for which you have already received payment, Amazon will refund you the amount of the referral fee you paid for the items, minus the applicable refund administration fee.

The refund administration fee is charged per unit returned. Rate based on percentage of transaction refunded or a flat rate. First, determine if the product type is a book, music, video, or DVD. Next, determine what percentage of the product charges have been refunded. To use this information, refer to the following rate card (US given as example):

- **Unplanned services fees**

When you comply with Fulfillment by Amazon's Packaging and prep requirements and Shipping and Routing Requirements, it enables efficient and accurate receipt and storage of your inventory at the fulfillment center. If there is a problem receiving inventory at an Amazon fulfillment center, Amazon will perform an unplanned service to place the product into your sellable inventory at your expense. Amazon escalates your inbound performance issues by Problem group. For repeated instances of the same problem group, Amazon will escalate your coaching level.

Tip

Unplanned service coaching and product prep work requires Amazon to expend its resources. For repeated instances of the same problem group¹ for products you ship, Amazon may escalate your coaching level² (standard, elevated, critical). Your coaching level is correlated to your unplanned services fees.

1. Problem groups are categories Amazon uses to organize issues that arise during the inbound process, including product related, box related, and pallet related.

2. Coaching level — When there is an issue with an item you ship to Amazon, Amazon will provide you with suggestions based on the problem group that most closely describes the issue or issues and determine the coaching level your issue belongs to.

2.3.5 Optional paid FBA services

In addition to the basic fees, Fulfillment by Amazon (FBA) offers other optional paid services to simplify various FBA processes. Following is an explanation of other FBA services and their fees.



- **FBA Prep Service**

Correct packaging and prep helps to reduce delays in receiving time, protect your products while in Amazon fulfillment centers, and create a better customer experience. You can use the FBA Prep Service to help reduce your logistics operations by having Amazon provide proper packaging and prep services for the products you ship. The FBA **Prep Service fee is calculated based on eligible product's prep category and size tier.**

- **FBA Label Service**

All products must have a scannable label that is visible after prep is complete. For eligible products that require a barcode label, you can have Amazon apply those barcode labels for you for a per-item fee. However, Label Service is not a mandatory part of Prep Service. You can also process product labels yourself and choose not to pay for this service.

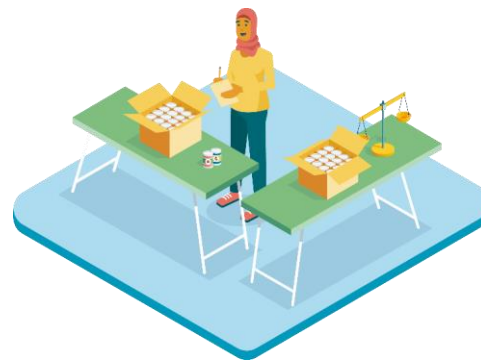
The FBA Label Service fee is \$0.55 per item.

- **FBA Manual Processing Service**

Every box you send to a fulfillment center requires accurate box content information to ensure that Amazon can receive your products quickly and correctly.

If you choose not to provide box content information, Amazon will manually process your boxes at the fulfillment center and a fee will apply. Shipments that are manually processed may be received more slowly than shipments with box content information.



Tips

- The FBA manual processing fee vary for different periods.
- The fee will be charged 14 days after the first unit of your shipment is received at the fulfillment center. You will be charged for the number of units received as of the date when the fee is charged. If your shipment contains units that are received after the FBA manual processing fee has already been charged on the shipment, you will be charged for these additional units at the next 14-day interval. This means that your fee preview may differ from the actual applicable charges.

- **FBA Repackaging and Refurbishment Services**

- **Repackaging service**

Fulfillment by Amazon (FBA) will repackage your eligible customer returns so that they can be sold as new. The service applies both to **retail and FBA return items**, and cannot be disabled in your settings.

- Each returned unit is evaluated to determine whether it can be repackaged.
- Repackaging can include replacing the poly bag or bubble wrapping, or re-boxing the item. It can also include repackaging of branded and unbranded boxes, and poly bags.

- **Refurbishment service**

Additional packaging services are available through optional refurbishment. FBA will assess the condition of the item and provide repackaging, cleaning, or reconditioning services (such poly-bagging, bubble wrap, boxing, or polishing)

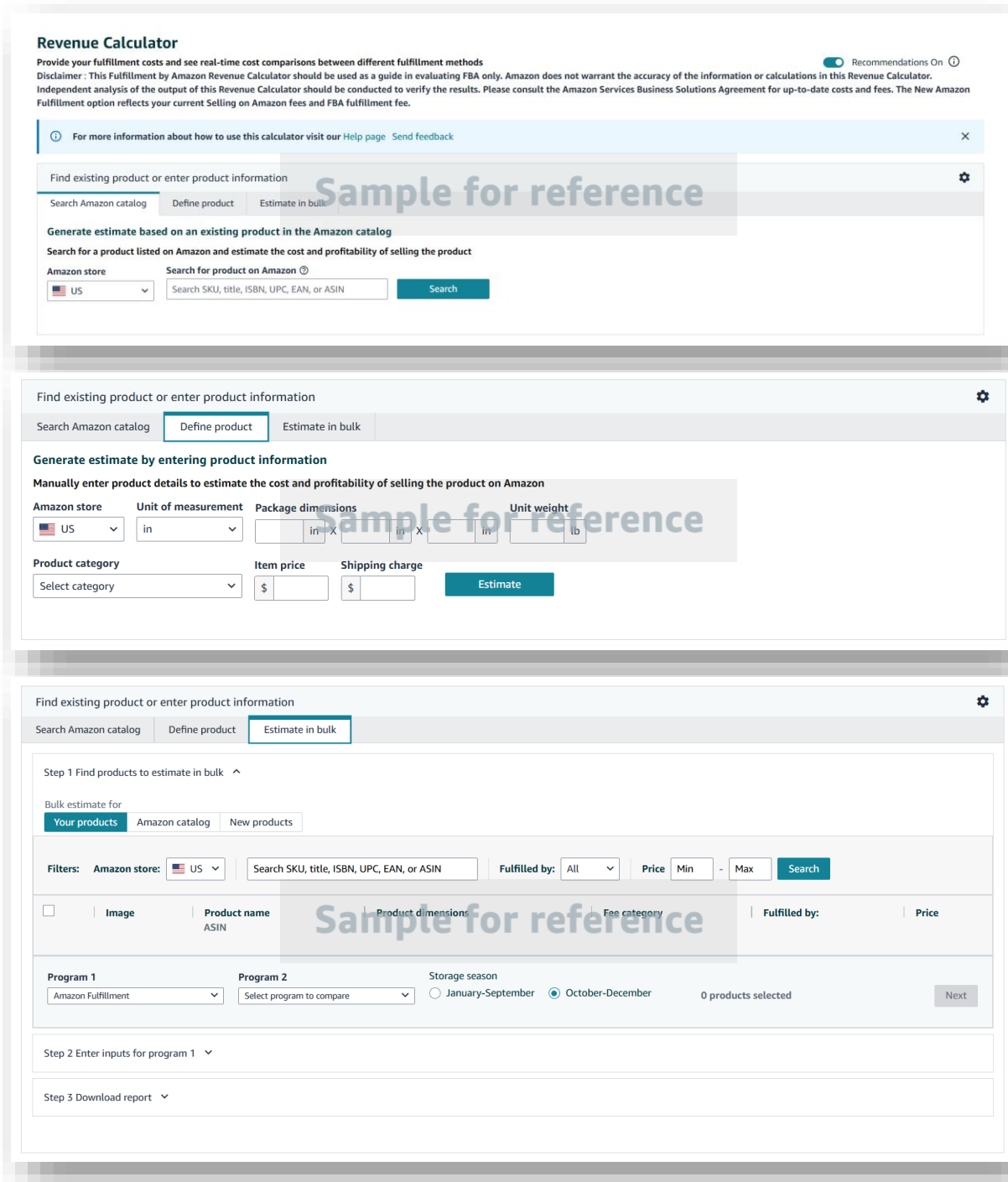

FBA	Fulfillment By Amazon provides a high standard, truly one-stop solution for warehousing, picking, packing, delivery, receipt, customer service, and returns services.
First-mile logistics	A cross-border seller transports products from China to the destination country.
Amazon Prime	A paid membership where shoppers who become Amazon Prime members enjoy a better shopping and logistics experience as well as exclusive benefits such as discounts and special members-only sales.
Prep	Before sending a shipment to an Amazon fulfillment center, you need to prepare your products. The pre-processing steps include unit or shipment packaging and unit, shipment, or pallet labeling.
Weight handling fee	The fee charged based on the dimensional weight of an item. The dimensional weight is the unit volume (based on length × width × height in inches) divided by 139.
Product size tier	Amazon divides products into tiers such as standard and oversized based on the weight and size of the product after packaging and charges fees according to this size tier.
Dangerous goods	Also known as dangerous goods and abbreviated as hazmat. They are substances or materials that may pose a risk to health, safety, property, or the environment during storage, handling, or transportation because they contain flammable, pressurized, corrosive, or otherwise harmful substances. These may include many consumer goods such as perfumes, cosmetics, household cleaners, and paint.
Average daily volume	Refers to the size of the space occupied by inventory per day on average within a month. The formula is length × width × height divided by the number of days in the month.
Aged inventory surcharge	The long-term storage fee (LTSF) is based on the time the product was received at the Amazon fulfillment center. Amazon will charge a per-unit aged inventory surcharge for products stored in a US fulfillment center for over 365 days.
Problem group	Problem groups are categories Amazon uses to organize issues that arise during the inbound process, including product related, box related, and pallet related.
Coaching level	When there is an issue with an item you ship to Amazon, Amazon will provide you with suggestions based on the problem group that most closely describes the issue or issues and determine the coaching level your issue belongs to.
