Mandatory Export Compliance Requirements for Indian Businesses

Depending on the product category being exported, the destination country, and the country of origin of the products, here's what every seller needs, to meet export requirements -

Importer Exporter Code (IEC)

- ▶ 10-digit business identification number
- ▶ Allotted to exporters by the DGFT
- ▶ Issued based on a PAN card

Authorized Dealer (AD) Code

- ▶ 14-digit code
- ▶ Given by the bank of the exporter's current account
- ▶ Prerequisite for obtaining AD code: IEC

Letter of Undertaking

- ▶ Filed for exporting without IGST
- ▶ Generated on the GST portal
- ▶ Avail benefits of zero-rated turnover

Importer of Record

- ▶ Individual/ entity to ensure that exported products are documented and valued by the Customs Border Protection.
- ▶ Responsible for paying taxes, filing duties, and associated documentation.
