1. Product Name

Coaxial to Ethernet Adapter

2. Product Overview

This product is a network adapter designed to convert existing coaxial cable connections into Ethernet-compatible ports. It is intended for home or office use to extend wired network connectivity by utilizing existing coaxial wiring infrastructure. The product emphasizes stable transmission, ease of installation, and compliance with applicable technical standards.

3. Safety Warnings

A. Intended Use: This product is intended for indoor use only. Do not use in moist, high-temperature, or dusty environments.

B. Electrical Safety:

Use only the provided power adapter (input: 100-240V AC, output: [specified voltage/current]).

Disconnect all power sources before installation or maintenance.

C. Age Restriction: Not a toy. Keep out of reach of children under 14 years of age.

D. Installation Precautions:

Ensure coaxial cables are not carrying satellite/TV signals simultaneously unless the adapter is specifically designed for such use.

5. Usage Instructions

A. Installation Steps:

- a. Locate an active coaxial wall outlet connected to your network source.
- b. Connect the coaxial cable from the wall outlet to the "Coax In" port on the adapter.
- c. Use an Ethernet cable to connect the "Ethernet Out" port on the adapter to your computer, router, or other network device.
- d. Plug the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet and connect it to the adapter.

B. Operation:

The LED indicator will light up (usually green or blue) to signal normal operation.

Refer to the device's manual for any configuration requirements (e.g., IP settings if applicable).

C. Removal:

Power off the adapter before disconnecting any cables.

Gently unplug all cables in reverse order of installation.

6. Cleaning and Maintenance

- A. Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasives.
- B. Avoid exposure to chemicals, water, or extreme temperatures.

C. When not in use, store in the original packaging or a dry, dust-free environment.
