

Hair Extensions Tape Remover Application Manual

Product Overview

This Hair Extensions Tape Remover is designed exclusively for professional use. This product facilitates the safe and efficient removal of tape hair extensions.

Safety Warnings and Precautions

Professional Use Only: This product must be used by qualified hair extension professionals only.

Allergic Reactions: This remover can cause allergic reactions in some individuals. A skin patch test should be performed before using the product.

Mandatory Skin Patch Test: Before using this product for the first time or on a new client, conduct a skin patch test to check for any allergic reaction.

Avoid Contact with Eyes: In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice.

Ventilation: Use in a well-ventilated area to avoid inhalation of fumes.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and out of reach of children.

Application Instructions

Consultation: Discuss with the client any known allergies or sensitivities and check the scalp and hair is in the correct condition for a hair extension application or removal service e.g., no open wounds, rashes, or inflammations.

Conduct a Skin Patch Test:

Apply a small amount of the remover on the client's neck at the hairline.
Wait for 48 hours. Monitor for any signs of redness, itching, or irritation.
Proceed only if no adverse reaction occurs in this time frame.

Preparation:

Ensure the hair and scalp are in the correct condition for a removal service e.g. no open wounds, rashes or inflammation. Ensure the hair is dry and free of any styling products.

Wear gloves to protect the hands from over exposure during the removal.

Application:

Generously spray the underneath and top side of the tape attachment area and leave for 30-60 seconds to loosen the adhesive.

Use the end of a pintail comb to gently prise the tape open then reapply the spray inside of the tape. Leave once more for 20-40 seconds to loosen the adhesive.

Gently peel the tape extension away from the natural hair and set aside. Use a fine-toothed comb and more spray if needed to remove all adhesive residue from the hair.

Once all the tape extensions and residue is removed thoroughly wash and rinse the clients hair with a clarifying shampoo to remove oil and remover. Condition hair well to restore moisture.

Conduct a scalp and hair inspection to ensure no irritation or damage has occurred.

Aftercare and Disposal

Advise clients to avoid using any harsh chemicals or treatments on their scalp for at least 24 hours after the removal process.

Dispose of any used materials in accordance with local regulations.

Emergency Information

In case of an adverse reaction or accidental ingestion, seek immediate medical attention. Keep the product label or manual handy as a reference for medical professionals.
