

LIMITED WARRANTY

With the exceptions listed below, ET2 Contemporary Lighting products are warranted to be free of defects in material and workmanship for ONE YEAR from date of shipment. The exceptions are:

- CounterMax® LED Under Cabinet MX-L120, MX-L120D, MX-L120DC, MX-L120-DL, MX-L120-EL, MX-L120-LO, MX-L, and MX-L-LPC will be warranted for normal use for 15 years or 40,000 hours, whichever comes first, and accessories for MX-L120 will be warranted for normal use for 5 years or 40,000 hours, whichever comes first, while the original purchaser owns it. Normal use means residential non-commercial use. For commercial use, products will be warranted for 10 years or 30,000 hours, whichever comes first, while the original purchaser owns it.
- CounterMax® MX-LMC and MX-LD will be warranted for normal use for 5 years or 40,000 hours, whichever comes first, while the original purchaser owns it. Normal use means residential non-commercial use. For commercial use, products will be warranted for 5 years or 30,000 hours, whichever comes first, while the original purchaser owns it.
- StarStrand® LED Tape Lighting System and system components (not including drivers) will be warranted for normal use for 5 years or 40,000 hours, whichever comes first, while the original purchaser owns it. Normal use means residential non-commercial use. For commercial use, products will be warranted for 5 years or 30,000 hours, whichever comes first, while the original purchaser owns it.
- StarStrand® LED Spec Star Tape Lighting and system components (not including drivers) will be warranted for normal use for 10 years or 60,000 hours, whichever comes first, and system components will be warranted for normal use for 5 years of 40,000 hours, whichever comes first, while the original purchaser owns it. Normal use means residential non-commercial use. For commercial use, products will be warranted for 10 years or 40,000 hours, whichever comes first, while the original purchaser owns it.
- StarStrand® drivers for the LED Tape Lighting System will be warranted for normal use for 3 years or 30,000 hours, whichever comes first, while the original purchaser owns it. Normal use means residential non-commercial use.
- Decorative LED chandeliers, pendants, wall sconces, flush mounts, and outdoor lanterns will be warranted for normal use for 10 years or 40,000 hours, whichever comes first, while the original purchaser owns it. Normal use means residential non-commercial use. For commercial use, products will be warranted for 5 years or 30,000 hours, whichever comes first, while the original purchaser owns it.

ET2 Contemporary Lighting will, at its election, repair, replace or make appropriate adjustment where ET2 Contemporary Lighting inspection discloses any such defects occurring in normal usage within one (1) year after date of shipment.
