



Froggie Collection Inflatable Tub allows you to bathe your baby in a safe, padded space. The attached “saddle horn” keeps baby from sliding down in the tub.

Recommended Age 6 months to 24 months

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

- Please thoroughly inspect product prior to use.
- Inflate the sides, bottom and saddle horn using the three separate valves (saddle horn inflation is optional and for preferred use). Squeeze each valve when blowing to release the automatic shut-off closure (this allows air to enter the chamber). When the chamber is inflated insert the top flap into the valve and press for closure.
- Place the tub at the far end of the bath tub (away from the faucet) and use a soft plastic container to fill the inflatable tub with water from bath tub faucet.
- Test the temperature of the water in, or being put into, the infant bath tub prior to placing the infant into the product. The typical water temperature for bathing a baby should be between 90 and 100 degrees F (32.2 and 37.8 degrees C).
- To deflate – remove the top flap from each valve and squeeze the valve to release air from each chamber. You may have to press down on each chamber to promote air flow from the chamber.
- To clean the Inflatable Tub – using a soft cloth wipe clean with water and mild soap. Rinse with warm water.
- Discontinue the use of the product if it becomes damaged, broken, or disassembled.

This product is an infant care accessory. This product is not a toy and is not to be used as a pool or float device. Do not leave child unattended in the inflatable tub – adult supervision required at all times.

⚠ WARNING

Drowning Hazard: Babies have **drowned** while using infant bath tubs.

To prevent drowning:

- **Stay in arm's reach** of your baby.
- **Never** rely on a toddler or preschooler to help your baby or alert you to trouble. Babies have drowned even with other children in or near bath tub.
- Babies can drown in as little as **1 inch** of water. Use as **little water as possible** to bathe your baby.

- Use in **empty** adult tub or sink.
- Keep drain **open** in adult tub or sink.

Fall Hazard: Babies have suffered **head injuries** falling from infant bathtubs.

To prevent falls:

- Place tub **only** in adult tub.
- **Never** **lift** or **carry** baby in tub.
