

Instruction Manual for Electric Hair Braider

Thank you for purchasing our Electric Hair Braider. With this automatic hair braiding tool, you can create your own stunning hairstyles easily and quickly. Please read the instructions carefully before use to ensure the finest experience.

Getting Started:

1. Confirm that you have everything you need which include: the electric hair braider machine, 2 girls' hair bows with clips and a pack of 500 colorful rubber bands. Please note: 2 AA batteries are required (NOT included).
2. Install the batteries: Open the battery compartment at the bottom of the braider and insert 2 AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity. Close the compartment.

Operating Instructions:

1. First, comb your hair to remove any tangles. Select 3 strands of your hair for braiding.
2. Insert each strand into the 3 hooks on the braiding machine. Ensure they are firm and evenly spaced.
3. Hold the device and press the button to start the braiding process. Release the button to stop.
4. After the desired braid length is reached, tie the braid end with one of the included rubber bands.
5. For a more appealing look, you can attach the bow hair clips to your braids.



Tips:

- If the device does not work properly, check and replace the batteries.
- This product should be used under adult supervision to prevent any hair entanglement.
- Avoid using the machine if the hair is too short, too long, or too thick, which might cause the device to jam.
- If the strand becomes tangled in the machine, immediately stop the device and carefully remove the hair.

Cleaning and Maintenance:

Clean the device with a clean dry cloth. The device is not waterproof, so don't immerse it in water to avoid any damage.

Storage:

Store the machine in a cool, dry place out of reach of children when not in use.
