### Before Use

- Remove all packaging before use.
- Perform a patch test on a small area of skin before first use, especially if you have sensitive skin.
- Avoid contact with eyes and mucous membranes.

- Not intended for use on infants' skin.
- 

### **Important Safety Instructions**

#### **WARNING**

- For external use only. Do not ingest.
- Not suitable for children under 3 years. Keep out of reach of infants.
- Do not use on broken, sunburned, inflamed, or irritated skin.
- Discontinue use immediately if redness, itching, burning, or irritation occurs. Consult a healthcare professional if symptoms persist.
- Avoid prolonged contact with eyes. In case of eye contact, rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- Do not use if you have known allergies to any listed ingredients.
- Natural soaps may soften when left in standing water; this does not affect safety but may shorten product life.

#### **CAUTION**

- If you have a dermatological condition (e.g., eczema, psoriasis, or chronic dryness), consult a healthcare professional before use.
  - Essential oils and natural extracts may cause sensitivity in rare cases.
  - Slippery surfaces: use caution in the bath or shower to prevent falls.

### **How to Use**

1. Wet your hands, body, and the soap bar with warm water.
2. For optimal lather, place the soap in a washing net or lather between your hands.
3. Apply the rich foam gently to the skin using circular motions.
4. Massage lightly; avoid excessive friction.
5. Rinse thoroughly with water.
6. After use, rinse the soap and place it on a well-draining soap dish.

#### **Recommended frequency:**

- Suitable for daily use for normal skin.
  - For sensitive or dry skin, adjust frequency as needed.

### **Care & Maintenance**

- Allow the soap to dry completely between uses.
- Store on a soap dish with drainage to prevent softening.
- Do not leave submerged in water.
- Natural color and scent variations may occur due to plant-based ingredients.

### Storage

- Store unused soap in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and high humidity.
- Keep away from heat sources and open flames.

---

### Disposal

- Dispose of as household waste according to local regulations.
- Packaging materials should be recycled or disposed of responsibly where facilities exist.

- **Ingredients:** Cocos Nucifera (Coconut) Oil, Elaeis Guineensis (Palm) Oil, Helianthus Annuus Hybrid (Hybrid Sunflower) Oil, Aqua (Water), Sodium Hydroxide, Chamaecyparis Obtusa (Hinoki) Oil

#### Yuzu Soap

- **Ingredients:** Cocos Nucifera (Coconut) Oil, Elaeis Guineensis (Palm) Oil, Aqua (Water), Helianthus Annuus Hybrid (Hybrid Sunflower) Oil, Sodium Hydroxide, Oryza Sativa (Rice) Bran Oil, Citrus Junos (Yuzu) Fruit Juice

#### Persimmon Soap

- **Ingredients:** Water, Coconut Oil, Palm Oil, Rice Bran Oil, Sodium Hydroxide, Castor Oil, Sesame Seed Oil, Shea Butter, Evening Primrose Oil, Tea Extract, Persimmon Tannin, Japanese Red Pine Leaf Oil

#### Applicable to all soaps:

- Naturally retained **plant-based glycerin** for a moisturizing feel
- Free from synthetic detergents
- Handcrafted in Japan using the traditional cold process method
