

Qardio App and Android compatibility

QardioArm and QardioBase work with iOS, Android and Kindle devices. QardioCore is currently available on iOS only. To use Qardio App or operate one or more Qardio devices, your smartphone or tablet will need to have Bluetooth 4.0 (or later). The Qardio App works with Android 5.0 "Lollipop" (or later) and requires access to google play
