



# HOW TO PREVENT KNIVES FROM THE RUST?



Periodically wipe your knives down with the oil, either honing oil or motor oil to prevent rust.



When the carving process is finished, take some time to clean and dry the blade.

Then sharpen it and polish it with a polishing compound. The next time it will be ready for work.



It's better to lubricate the blade with a honing oil or motor oil before long-time storing it in a container.

After storage, remove the oil with a dry cloth.







Never wash the knives.

The aggressive detergent easily damages the blade.

If rust appears on the blade, remove it with a fine grit emery cloth and then polish it with a polishing compound.





Store the knives in a safe and dry place.

Rather than keeping the tools in a box, store them in a container or bag with separate compartments.
