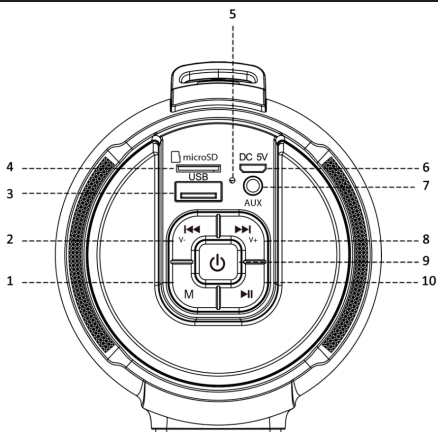

CHARGING






- Please fully charge the Volcano Mamba Series Bluetooth Speaker before using it for the first time.
- Connect the USB A end of the charging cable to a USB charging port and insert the micro USB end to the port on the speaker. Make sure it is properly connected.
- The red indicator light will be lit while the speaker is charging. When the battery is full, the red indicator light will switch off automatically.
- Please do not charge the speaker for more than 8 hours.

PAIRING WITH BLUETOOTH DEVICES

Your speaker must be paired to a Bluetooth device before it can be used. It is only necessary to pair your speaker once with each device.

1. Press and hold the  Power Button for about 3 seconds until the blue LED light turns on and starts flashing.
2. Cycle to Bluetooth mode by pressing the **M** Mode Button, the speaker will beep twice, this means that the speaker is ready to pair with your Bluetooth playback device.

Pairing a second Mamba Speaker / Daisy Chaining:

3. The Volcano Mamba Speakers needs to pair to each other before connecting to your Bluetooth device.
4. Once the speakers are in Bluetooth Mode press and hold the  Play / Pause and FM Auto Scan Button for 3 seconds on one of your speakers, this will pair your two speakers together, a connection tone will be audible once both speakers are paired. It is only necessary to pair your speakers with each other once.
5. Activate the Bluetooth on your playback device and search for "Mamba". Select "Mamba" from the device's list to connect. You will hear a connection tone after the speaker has been paired successfully and the Bluetooth LED will start flashing slower.
6. You can now playback audio through the speaker.
7. Music tracks can be selected either on the speaker or on your playback device (smartphone, computer, tablet etc.). Press the  / **V+** Next Track / Volume Up Button to skip to the next song. Press the **V-** /  Previous Track / Volume Down Button to play the previous song.
8. Volume can be controlled either on the speaker or on your playback device (smartphone, computer, tablet etc.). Press and hold the  / **V+** Next Track / Volume Up Button or the **V-** /  Previous Track / Volume Down Button on the speaker to adjust the volume as preferred.
9. Press the  Button on the speaker to play or stop music.

CONTROLS

Previous Track	Short press the V- / ◄◄ Previous Song / Previous Station / Volume Down Button
Play / Pause Track	Short press the ►■ Play / Pause and FM Auto Scan Button

To navigate between the USB, Micro SD, Bluetooth and Aux Modes short press the **M** Mode Button.

2. Bluetooth, USB and SD Card Mode

Function	Operation
Increase Volume	Long press the ►► / V+ Next Song / Next Station / Volume Up Button
Decrease Volume	Long press the V- / ◄◄ Previous Song / Previous Station / Volume Down Button
Next Track	Short press the ►► / V+ Next Song / Next Station / Volume Up Button
Previous Track	Short press the V- / ◄◄ Previous Song / Previous Station / Volume Down Button
Play / Pause Track	Short press the ►■ Play / Pause and FM Auto Scan Button

Note: Increase and decrease buttons can work in Aux Input Mode.

3. FM Radio

Function	Operation
Increase Volume	Long press the ►► / V+ Next Song / Next Station / Volume Up Button
Decrease Volume	Long press the V- / ◀◀ Previous Song / Previous Station / Volume Down Button
Navigate up through saved channels	Short press the ►► / V+ Next Song / Next Station / Volume Up Button
Navigate down through saved channels	Short press the V- / ◀◀ Previous Song / Previous Station / Volume Down Button
Automatic Station Scan	Short press the ►◄ Play / Pause and FM Auto Scan Button

Playing MP3's from a USB Flash Drive or Micro SD Card

1. Switch the power on.
2. Insert USB flash disk or SD card into the slot. The music stored will be played automatically.
3. Music tracks can be selected either on the speaker or on your playback device (smartphone, computer, tablet etc.). Press the ►► / **V+** Next Track / Volume Up Button to skip to the next song. Press the **V-** / ◀◀ Previous Track / Volume Down Button to play the previous song.
4. Volume can be controlled either on the speaker or on your playback device (smartphone, computer, tablet etc.). Press and hold the ►► / **V+** Next Track / Volume Up Button or the **V-** / ◀◀ Previous Track / Volume Down Button on the speaker to adjust the volume as preferred.
5. Press the ►◄ Play / Pause and FM Auto Scan Button to play or pause the music.

Note: In Bluetooth Mode, inserting a USB flash disk will disconnect the Bluetooth and switch to playing from the USB flash disk. Press the **M** Mode Button to switch back to Bluetooth mode.

Aux-In

1. Press **M** Mode Button to cycle the speaker to Aux mode.
2. Plug the provided audio cable into the compatible device's Aux input and then into the Aux input of the speaker.

FM Radio Mode

1. Use the provided audio cable as an antenna to receive a good FM radio signal.
2. Once the device has been turned on, press the **M** Mode Button to cycle to FM radio mode.
3. Press the **▶||** Play / Pause and FM Auto Scan Button to search for all available FM channels and store them automatically.
4. To navigate between radio stations, press the **▶▶ / V+** Next Track / Volume Up Button or the **V- / ◀◀** Previous Track / Volume Down Button to select radio stations.

Note: Inserting the audio cable while the speaker is in FM mode, will cause the speaker to automatically switch to Aux mode. Pressing the **M** Mode Button again will cycle back to FM mode.

LOCATING THE BLUETOOTH MENU

iPhone, iPad, and iPod Touch:

- a) On your device, go to Settings.
- b) Select Bluetooth. If Bluetooth is not on, turn it on.
- c) The iPhone / iPad / iPod will automatically search for new devices.

Android Phones and Tablets:

- a) On your device, go to the Settings Menu.
- b) Select Bluetooth (on older Android devices Bluetooth is found in the Wireless and Networks Menu). If Bluetooth is not on, turn it on.
- c) Select "Search for Devices" if your phone or tablet does not automatically search for new devices.

NOTE: If you are unsure on how to access your Bluetooth Menu on your device, please refer to your device's instruction manual.

Troubleshooting

1. My smartphone cannot find any new Bluetooth devices?

- a. Ensure the device has entered the pairing mode.
- b. Ensure the device is within an effective working range.

2. Bluetooth device cannot pair up?

Ensure your mobile phone allows new connections and has not reached the maximum number of allowed devices.

3. The device does not play music when it is connected to a Bluetooth mobile phone.

- Ensure your mobile phone supports A2DP profiles.
- Ensure your mobile phone is within an effective working range.

4. When paired with my computer, Windows asks for a new driver.

Can you supply this?

We recommend you find compatible drivers for your computer online.

5. Why can I not remotely control the Pause / Play / Previous / Next functions when music is playing?

This feature needs the Bluetooth device paired with the speaker to support AVRCP (Audio / Video Remote Control Profile). Please ensure your device supports this.

Safety Precaution

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the surface of your Volcano Mamba Series Speaker using a soft, slightly damp cloth.
- Do not use any harsh or abrasive cleaning chemicals or materials on your Volcano Mamba Series Speaker as doing so may damage or scratch the surface finish.
- Do not expose Volcano Mamba Series Speaker to direct sunlight or high temperatures for extended periods of time.
- Do not store in temperatures over 60°C. Do not expose the battery to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like. Store in a cool, dry place.
- **DO NOT** submerge or expose your Mamba Series Speaker or any parts, including the cables, power supply or inner workings in or to water.
- **DO NOT** drag your Volcano Mamba Series Speaker across the floor. Doing so may damage the base of the unit or the surface you a pulling your device across.

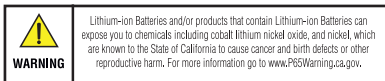
