

MARSHMALLOW TIPS AND TRICKS

Frequently asked questions:

- Sometimes the Marshmallows I buy are sticky. Is there a way to correct this to prevent gumming and miss fire in my shooter?
- Is there a way to improve my loading and shooting experience?

The answer to the questions: Cornstarch

- **Cornstarch** is a main ingredient in marshmallows
- Cornstarch **prolongs the life** of the marshmallow in an open air environment.
- **Cornstarch acts as a lubricant** in the magazine and barrel, reducing friction and preventing marshmallow jams and gumming.
- **Cornstarch** also **creates a cool puff of white smoke** when the marshmallows exit the barrel.
- **Cornstarch makes clean up easy** in areas where marshmallows may stick.

How to add Cornstarch: It doesn't take much

- Add **one table spoon of Cornstarch** to a Fresh bag of marshmallows.
- Close the bag of marshmallows and **shake well**. This will ensure all marshmallows are covered with Cornstarch.
- Now the marshmallows are ready to **Load**.
