

HOW IT WORKS



- 1 **Take** the silicone mold **out** of BERLINZO Premium Ice ball maker.
- 2 **Fill** the water storage box with **lukewarm drinking-tap water*** up to the measuring line (about 2" from the top).
- 3 Slowly **press** both parts of the mold into the water storage box. Make sure **the water fills the holes.**
- 4 **Put** BERLINZO Premium Ice Ball Maker with molds in the freezer for **about 20–24 hours**, depending on the power of your freezer, but for no longer than 30 hours to prevent the water storage box from cracking.
- 5 **Take** the mold **out** of your BERLINZO Premium Ice Ball Maker by slowly and evenly pulling the handles up **individually one at a time.** The mold should extract smoothly. **A hint:** if you have any difficulties with taking

out the mold, leave it for 7–10 minutes, so the ice melts a little bit, making the extraction process easier.

- 6 **Separate** the two parts of the mold and **cut off** the excess ice (with a knife). Now you have perfectly shaped ice for your beverage of choice. And you can **store** it for later in our Premium BERLINZO ziplock bag, which fits up to **six** 2.4-inch ice balls in.
- 7 To prevent the ice from cracking, **leave** the ice in a glass at room temperature for about **3–5 minutes**, and then pour the drink in. **Enjoy. Repeat.**

A SMALL TIP

Make some crushed ice with the leftover ice in the bottom of the container. Turn the container upside down and place it under the hot water, so the ice starts melting and can be taken out of the container. Then, crush or dice the ice with a knife, and it's ready to be served.
