
#### FITS STANDARD AND CLAWFOOT BATHS

The design extends to fit a wide range of bathtubs and spa baths, with ergonomic grooves to keep it from slipping or sliding.


#### THE EXPANDABLE BAMBOO CADDY SIZE:



#### THE BATH TRAY EXPANDS FROM 29.5" TO 43".




Be advised, that your tub's basin width and overall dimensions are crucial to bear in mind when in the market for a bath tray caddy.




- It's important to note that bath basins tend to range between
- 22-25 inches in width.

This can, in effect, determine how comfortably your tray sits within your tub. The length of your caddy and its wings can take up more room than you might anticipate.



The side wings/legs that rest on either side of your tub measure **3.6 inches** in length.




Moreover, we understand that for some, a bath tray may not even be an option, no matter how large your tub is.


That being due to many baths lacking a ledge for the tray to rest on as they are up against a wall one on side.




With that, we encourage you to examine your tub for any other fetures that could restrict your caddy from resting evenly across either side.

- Make sure that its dimensions when closed are no larger than
- your tub's edge-to-edge size.

OUR PACKAGING INCLUDES FOUR SILICONE GRIPS TO KEEP YOUR CADDY IN PLACE.



Simply, install the slip grips by separating the silicone component into four sections and sticking them to the bottom corners of your caddy's handles/legs.





# HOW TO CLEAN YOUR BAMBOO BATHTUB CADDY






Bamboo is known and loved for its naturally antibacterial surface, aesthetically pleasing design and durable composition. However, it's important to properly care for your bamboo caddy to ensure its lasting use and prevent any bacteria build-up.



For proper maintenance, we advise you to clear your board of any damp items or additional accessories after each use. Additionally, you should wash your caddy with mild soap.

## HOW TO CLEAN BAMBOO BATHTUB CADDY




Wipe down dry after each use before stowing away in a dry place in the upright position.


This way you avoid the risk of your board warping as is common with bamboo when left exposed to high humidity levels.




Be warned however, that bamboo products are **NOT** dishwasher nor bleach safe.








The most efficient way to effectively remove mold on bamboo is some cleaning products available in the market. But, unfortunately, they are often full of chemicals that can be harmful to your health. An alternative method, that can also do the trick, is lemon oil or vinegar.



Remove bamboo mold, white spores, and mildew with a soft brush and clean up the area with a damp cloth. Use lemon oil or a solution of vinegar and water to remove the mold.


Make sure though, to first clean the item with turpentine and dry it completely thereafter. If you don't, mold might grow underneath the polyurethane finish and cause blisters.




#### THE BEST RECIPE IS:




Fill a sink/deep bowl with hot water.




Add 2 tsp. of liquid dish soap and mix until all of the water is soapy and sudsy.




Put the bathtub caddy tray in the sink/bowl and scrub it with the soapy water until it looks clean.



Rinse the bathtub caddy with clean water.



Fill a spray bottle with 1 cup of water and 3 tbsp. of white vinegar.



Spray the solution over the caddy and let it sit for 10 minutes.




Wipe the bathtub caddy tray with a paper towel and let it air dry.



# THE MAINTENANCE OF A BAMBOO BATHTUB CADDY TRAY
