2. **FAILURE TO READ OR FOLLOW THESE WARNINGS CAN RESULT IN DEATH, INJURY OR PROPERTY DAMAGE.**
3. **THIS IS NOT A TOY. DO NOT LET CHILDREN PLAY WITH RAMPS OR NEAR THE RAMPS.**
4. **DO NOT** exceed the recommended weight limit of 3,250 lbs. per individual, 6,500 lbs. per pair, or 13,000 lbs. Vehicle Gross Weight.
5. **ONLY USE ON HARD LEVEL SURFACE CAPABLE OF SUSTAINING THE LOAD.**
6. Use on anything other than flat, hard surfaces could lead to injury, death, or property damage.
7. **PLEASE CENTER LOAD** between ramp's sides. Place ramp inclines tightly and in the middle of either the L&R front or L&R rear wheels.
8. Ramps must align with the vehicle and have their wheels pointing directly forward.
9. To support either the front or rear end of a vehicle, **USE ONLY AS MATCHED PAIR.**
10. **INSPECT AND ASSESS RAMPS PRIOR TO EACH USE.** If broken or damaged, **DO NOT USE.**
11. Each ramp should have rubber feet, and debris and oil should be removed from the ramps. If worn or damaged, destroy and throw away.
12. The driver of the vehicle should be observed and directed as they go up and down the ramps by a second person who is standing clear from vehicle path.
13. Ramps **ARE NOT TO BE USED TO SUPPORT A VEHICLE ON ONE SIDE OR BOTH ENDS AT THE SAME TIME.**
14. **NOT INTENDED** for storage on the incline of the ramps. Please **DO NOT** use as a leveling device.
15. Use on vehicles with **MAXIMUM 12-INCH TIRE WIDTH.**
16. The ramps **ARE NOT TO BE USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH OTHER LIFTING EQUIPMENT.**
17. While the car is on the ramps, **DO NOT** disconnect the brakes, the engine, the gearbox, the drive train, the drive shaft, the universal joints, or the wheels.
18. **NEVER SUDDENLY ACCELERATE OR APPLY THE BRAKES.** Move carefully and slowly.
19. Only use the brakes to prevent overtravel once the car has reached the top of the ramps.
20. When climbing, braking could cause ramps to slide or tip.
21. **RAMPS SHOULD NOT BE USED ON SLIPPERY OR SLICK SURFACE.**
22. Put the car in neutral and release the brakes when the tires touch down in the cradle section

of the ramps.

**23. THE VEHICLE SHOULD NOT MOVE. ENABLE OR SET EMERGENCY BRAKE.**

- 24. Put the car in park (or in reverse gear for manual transmissions). Chock wheel on ground.
- 25. Make sure the support structure for the ramp is level and that both tires are positioned correctly.
- 26. Shake the vehicle sideways and endways to check that the vehicle and ramps are stable, practice caution to keep your body away from any potential hazards and danger.
- 27. Verify that the ramps were not damaged or bent during loading.
- 28. Use only the attachments and/or adapters that the manufacturer provided.
- 29. If a ramp appears to have been subjected to an abnormal load or shock, inspect immediately for damage.

**30. DO NOT MODIFY RAMPS.**

- 31. Before the use of this product is permitted, the operator must receive this warning in the operator's native language.
- 32. Make sure the operator is fully aware of the risks connected to the proper usage and misuse of these ramps.
