



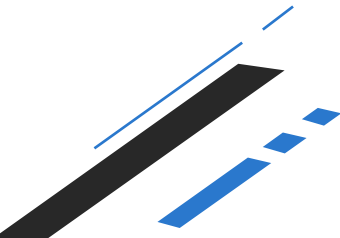
INDOOR *INSECT TRAP*

PRODUCT USE INSTRUCTIONS



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INTRODUCTION

The **Trapex Insect Trap** is a compact and efficient device designed to attract and capture a wide range of flying insects, such as mosquitoes, Moths, Flies, and gnats. Using advanced technology, it emits **UV light** to attract, a silent fan to funnel in, and secures the insect with an adhesive sticky pad. This trap is safe, non-toxic, and easy to use.

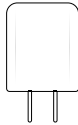
Before using the **Trapex Insect Trap**, ensure that you have the following items ready:

TRAPEX INSECT TRAP COMPONENTS

The **Trapex Insect Trap** consist of the following components:



UV Light Panel: Emits ultraviolet light to attract insects.



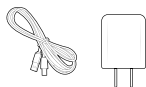
Adhesive Pad: A sticky surface that captures the trapped insects.



Catchment Tray: Holds sticky pad and collects any fallen insects or debris.



Power Button: Turns the device on and off.



Power Cord: Supplies power to the device.



Bait Pod: For putting ingredients to attract insects.

OPERATING THE TRAPEX INSECT TRAP

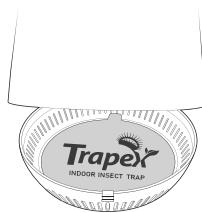
To operate the **Trapex Insect Trap**, follow these steps:

Step 1: Placement

- Choose an optimal location for the trap, preferably near areas where insects are commonly found such as kitchens near trash, fruit bowls, or flowers. The trap is also effective near indoor plants.
- Ensure that the trap is placed at a height of around 3-6 feet from the ground.
- Keep the trap away from competing lights (turn off all the lights in the area at night for the best result), as they may distract insects from entering.

Step 2: Placement of Sticky Pad

- Remove the film of a sticky pad, bend the tab, and place in catchment tray.



Step 3: Power Connection (if applicable)

- Your **Trapex Insect Trap** model includes a power cord and plug adapter, plug one end into the trap's power input port.
- Connect the other end to a suitable power outlet.

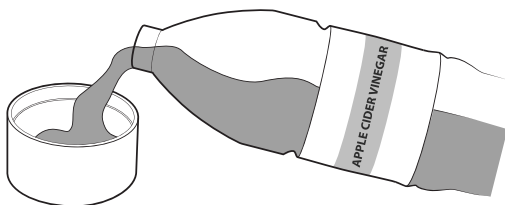
Step 4: Power On

- Press power button on rear of the unit near the usb port.
- The UV light will illuminate and the fan will begin running attracting insects towards the trap.

Step 5: Capturing Insects

- Flying insects are drawn to the UV light and will approach the trap.
- Once in proximity, the insects will become stuck to the adhesive Pad.
- The trapped insects will remain on the pad until removed or replaced.

Fill the bait cap Trapex works night and day, the removable bait pod can be filled with liquids like apple cider vinegar to lure in flying insects.



MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

To ensure the **Trapex's** effectiveness and longevity, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Power off the device and unplug the power cord (if applicable) before performing any maintenance or cleaning.
- Regularly check the adhesive pad for captured insects. If the pad is full replace it with a new one following the manufacturer's instructions.
- Clean the catchment tray periodically by removing it from the trap and wiping it with a damp cloth. Allow it to dry completely before reinserting it.
- Inspect the UV light panel for dust or debris buildup. If necessary clean it gently with a soft, lint-free cloth.



TROUBLESHOOTING

- If you encounter any issues with the **Trapex Insect Trap**, refer to the following troubleshooting tips:
- **Insects are not being captured:** Ensure that the trap is placed in a suitable location where insects are present. Check the adhesive pad for proper installation and replace it if necessary. Clean the UV light panel to maximize its attractiveness.
- **The trap is not turning on:** Check the power connection (if applicable) and ensure that the power switch is in the 'On' position. If using a power cord, ensure it is plugged into a functional power outlet.
- **Other technical issues:** If you encounter any other technical problems or concerns, please refer to the warranty information or contact us through **Amazon.com customer service** (see section 9).

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- To ensure your safety and the proper functioning of the **Trapex Insect Trap**, please adhere to the following precautions.
- Keep the trap out of reach of children and pets.
- Do not expose the trap to water or other liquids.
- Avoid touching the **UV light panel** while it is operational, as it may become warm.
- When cleaning or handling the trap, ensure it is powered off and unplugged (if applicable).
