2019 Mowbray Boy Pinot Noir

Region

The Tamar Valley is located in the north of Tasmania, a cool climate wine region synonymous with Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. A diverse region influenced by the Tamar River, with rich and fertile soil, and gentle rains that arrive from the Southern Ocean. A renown region for producing exceptional quality wine.

Vintage

2019 provided an excellent vintage for Tasmania. It was a warmer than average season, with measured heat and it was generally dry, reducing disease pressure. With above-average yields in Tamar Valley, fruit purity and quality are outstanding.

Wine

Fruit was placed in an open ferment with a small percentage of whole bunch fermentation to give structure aromatics and spiciness to Pinot Noir. The fruit spent 10 days on skins in total, was gently pressed, then run straight to barrels, with a small percentage of new oak.

This Pinot Noir showcases typical Tamar Valley characteristics of savoury spicy red cherries. An unctuous palate with bright crunchy fruit, savouriness, and dripping with ripe strawberries. It's a fine, elegant, structured wine that will have you salivating just thinking about it.
