- 01** For countertop use only. Always operate the appliance on a stable, non-combustible, level surface.
- 02** For household use only. Not for commercial use. DO NOT use the appliance for anything other than its intended use.
- 03** Make sure that your outlet voltage corresponds to the voltage stated on the rating label, located on the sticker under the base.
- 04** DO NOT operate the appliance while the pitcher is empty.
- 05** Avoid spillage on the connector.
- 06** To protect against fire, electric shock and injury to persons, DO NOT immerse the power cord, plug, pitcher or the appliance base in water or other liquid.
- 07** Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. After using a program that heats, there will be residual heat within the pitcher. Allow the appliance to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning.

- 12 Always operate the appliance with the lid in place. DO NOT remove the lid while frothing to avoid scalding injury.
- 13 Avoid contacting moving parts. Keep hands and utensils out of the pitcher while frothing to reduce the risk of personal injury and/or property damage.
- 14 Some parts of the appliance are hot when the appliance is in operation. Only use the handle to move or carry the pitcher.
- 15 Extreme caution must be used when moving the appliance when it contains hot liquids.

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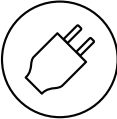

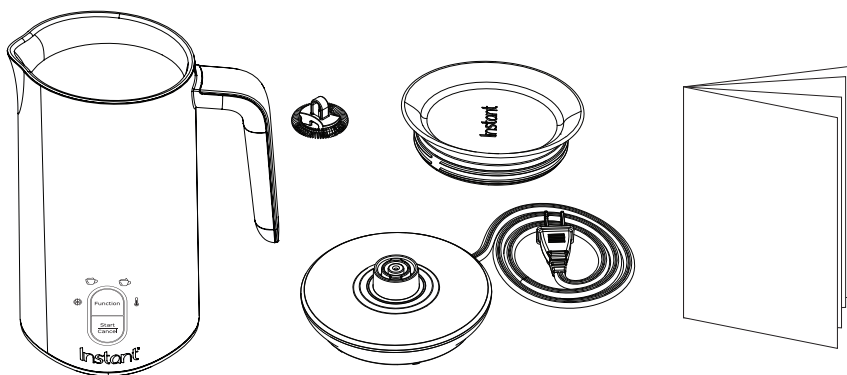

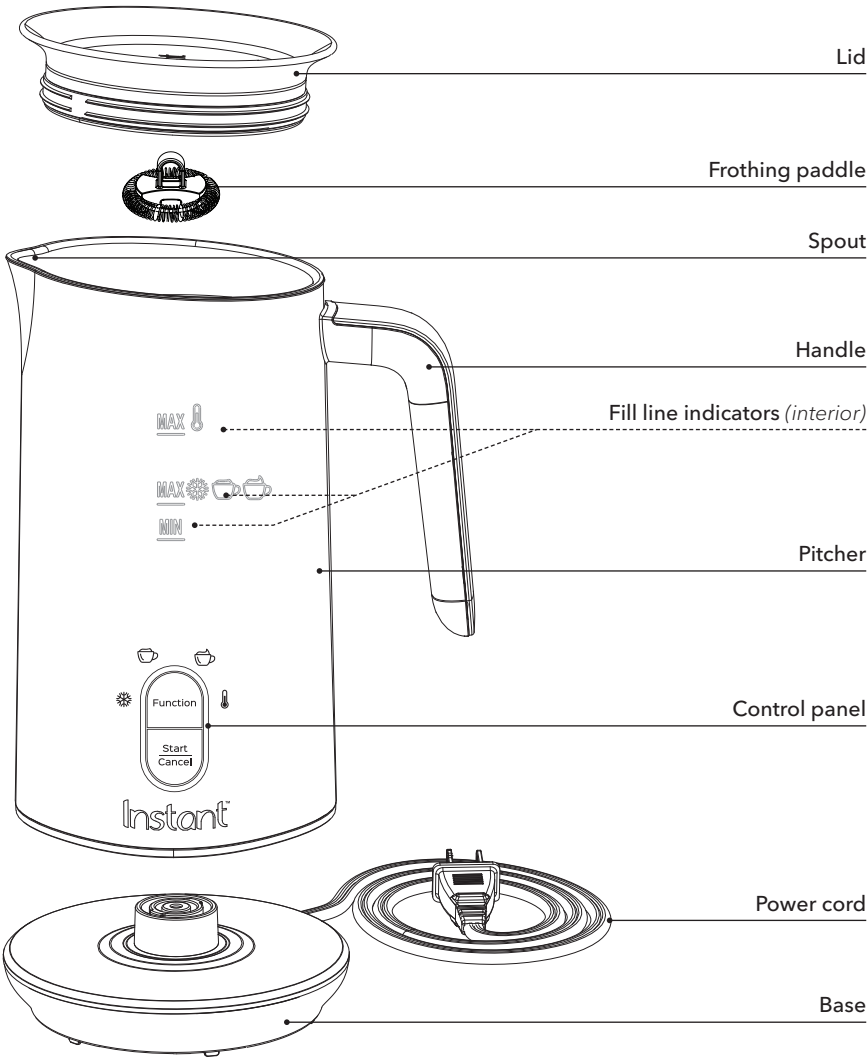

Instant Milk Frother

Make sure everything is installed properly before use.

Initial setup

Is your drink missing a little somethin' somethin'? Get this little guy going and start showing off your foam flair.

- 01** Pull your new milk frother out of the box!
- 02** Remove all the packaging material and accessories from in and around the appliance. Make sure to check inside the pitcher!
- 03** Place the milk frother base on a stable, level surface.
- 04** Follow the instructions in **Initial cleaning** before frothing for the first time.

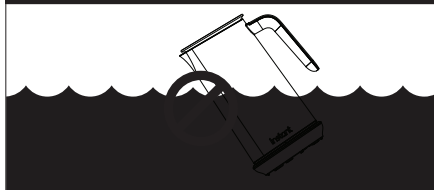
Initial cleaning

Before using your milk frother, it's important to clean the components.

- 01** Disassemble the milk frother into 3 parts:
 - The lid
 - The frothing paddle (pull up gently to remove)
 - The pitcher
- 02** Hand wash the lid, the frothing paddle, and the inside of the pitcher with hot water and dish soap. Do not immerse the pitcher in water or other liquid.
- 03** Rinse the lid, the frothing paddle, and the inside of the pitcher with clear, warm water, then dry them thoroughly with a soft cloth.

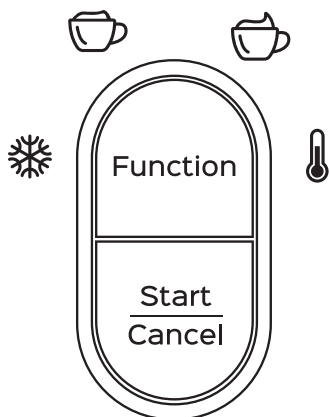
That's it! Start whipping up that fresh, fluffy foam.

The pitcher and base contain electrical components. To avoid fire, electric shock or personal injury, **DO NOT** machine wash, rinse or immerse the milk frother base, pitcher, power cord or plug in water or other liquids.

Making drinks



The Instant Milk Frother was designed with 2 easy-to-use button controls.

Function

Toggles through the preset programs to create various types of foam to suit your tastes.

Start/Cancel

Starts and stops the selected program.



The **cold foam** setting creates a luscious, silky microfoam filled with millions of tiny bubbles. Use milk and coconut milk for the perfect cold brew topper.



The Milk Frother does not chill when frothing. Use chilled liquid.



The **warm foam** setting heats and froths, and with a gentle swirl of the pitcher at the end, creates a loose style of warm microfoam – like a cloud floating on your café au lait and lattes.



The **warm, thick foam** setting heats and froths your liquid to create a rich, dense style of warm microfoam. The crowning touch for your cappuccino.



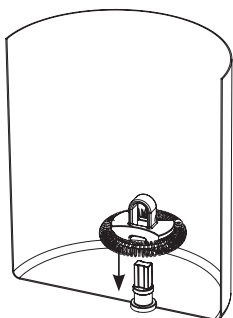
The **warm, no foam** setting heats your drink without generating any foam. This setting automatically slow-stirs your drink to keep it from scorching, for amazing steamed milk, hot chocolate and more!

Making drinks

Set up the Milk Frother for use

- 01** Remove the lid from the pitcher.
- 02** Position the square end of the frothing paddle over the shaft at the bottom of the pitcher.

Rotate the frothing paddle until it aligns with the shaft, then push the frothing paddle down until it is secure.



- 03** For cold foam, warm foam, or warm, thick foam, fill the pitcher to between the **MIN** and **MAX** ☼☕☕ lines.

To warm without creating foam, fill the pitcher to between the **MIN** and **MAX** 🌡 lines.

 Overfilling may cause the milk frother to overflow when using a foaming setting. Do not overfill the pitcher.

- 04** Place the lid on the pitcher and press down until it is secure.
- 05** Place the pitcher on the base.
- 06** Connect the power cord to a 120 V outlet.

NOTICE

Do not attempt to froth if the liquid level is below the **MIN** fill line as indicated on the inside of the pitcher.

Settings

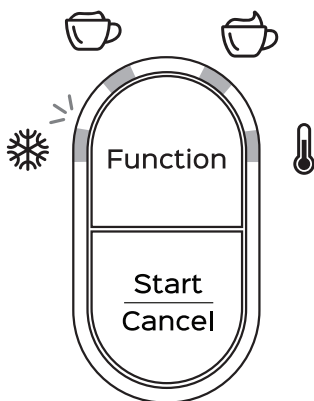
01 Press **Function** to toggle between all settings.

 Cold foam

 Warm foam

 Warm, thick foam

 Warm, no foam



The light that corresponds to the selected program blinks.

02 Press **Start/Cancel**.

The light stays illuminated and the program starts after a few seconds.

03 To stop the program at any time, press **Start/Cancel**.

When the program ends, the milk frother stops.



Programs will only run for a maximum of 3 minutes.

Frothing tips

Follow these tips and tricks to make sure you're treating yourself to the best drink possible.

Tip	How to do it and why
The colder the liquid the better.	Always use the coldest, freshest milk or milk alternative possible before frothing. When frothing, millions of tiny air bubbles are introduced into the liquid. The longer it takes to heat up, the more air can be infused into the liquid. This immediately enhances the quality of your foam, and reduces your chances of scalding. No more bad froth days! Note: Warm milk will not foam up properly.
Not all milk alternatives produce foam.	Oat and soy milk will create foam using either the warm or cold foaming settings. Coconut milk will only froth using the cold foam setting.
Infuse your foam with flavor.	Before frothing, add aromatic spices to the pitcher, like cinnamon, cardamom or nutmeg, or other fragrant items like lavender. The longer you allow your ingredients to steep, the stronger the flavors will be. It's a tasty mix and match! Join the official Instant Pot® Facebook Community to let us know your favorite bevv's unique flavor profile.
Give your milk frother a break!	When frothing big batches, allow the milk frother to rest for about 3 minutes after every 2 frothing cycles.
Making latte worthy foam.	As soon as the frother finishes whipping up your warm foam, lift the pitcher off the base, put your thumb on the lid and give it a good swirl! This helps give your latte foam the glossiness it deserves.

Care, cleaning and storage

Clean your Instant Milk Frother after every use to ensure the best possible flavor and to prevent milk from baking onto the inside of the pitcher.

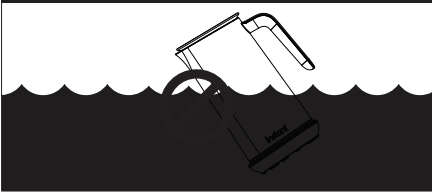
Always unplug the milk frother and let it cool to room temperature before cleaning. Never use metal scouring pads, abrasive powders or harsh chemical detergents on any of the milk frother's parts or components.

Let all parts dry thoroughly before use or before storage.

Parts	Cleaning methods and instruction
Lid	Remove from the pitcher before cleaning. Dishwasher safe.
Pitcher	Remove the pitcher from the base before cleaning. With a cloth, hand wash the inside of the pitcher with hot water and dish soap and rinse it with clean, warm water. With a barely-damp cloth, hand wash the outside of the pitcher and wipe dry to prevent streaking. DO NOT rinse the pitcher's exterior. DO NOT store liquid in the pitcher.
Frothing paddle	Remove from the pitcher before cleaning. Dishwasher safe.
Base	With a barely damp cloth, wipe visible particles from the base as needed. Allow to dry thoroughly before placing the pitcher.
Power cord	With a barely damp cloth, wipe visible particles from the power cord as needed. DO NOT fold the power cord when storing.

Resolution table

Problem	Possible reason	Try this
Milk is not frothing.	The frothing paddle is not installed correctly.	Remove the liquid from the pitcher. Position the square end of the frother paddle over the shaft at the bottom of the pitcher and push down until it is secure.
	Milk is too hot.	Put your milk in the fridge or freezer to bring the temperature down.
	The inside of the pitcher or the frothing paddle contains milk residue.	Clean the pitcher and frothing paddle according to Care, cleaning and storage instructions.
	Different types and brands of milk and non-dairy milk alternatives may froth differently.	Experiment to find your favorite foam.
The Warm Foam and the Warm Thick Foam lights blink repeatedly.	The milk frother has overheated.	Unplug and wait up to 10 mins for the milk frother to cool before further use.
All four LEDs blink repeatedly.	The unit is defective or damaged.	The unit needs to be serviced by an authorized service representative. Contact Customer Care.

Any other servicing should be performed by an authorized service representative.

Warranty

Limited Warranty

This Limited Warranty is effective for one year from the date of original consumer purchase. Proof of original purchase date and, if requested by an authorized representative of Instant Brands Inc. ("Instant Brands"), return of your appliance, is required to obtain service under this Limited Warranty. 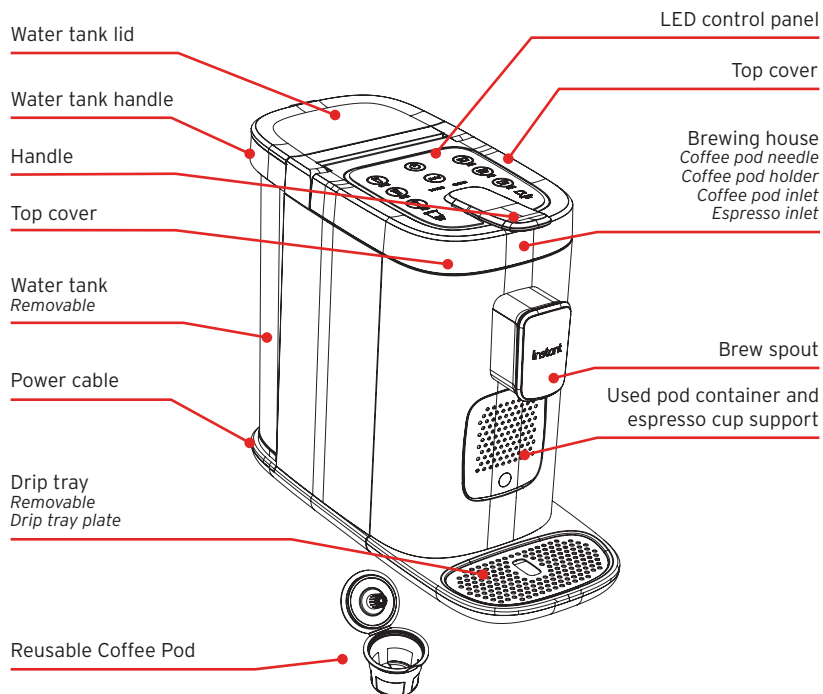

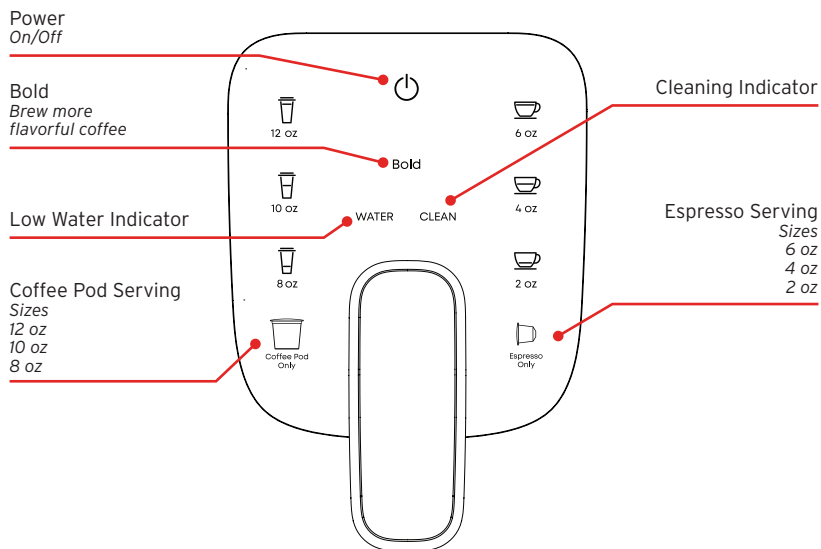

Control panel

Here's a look at the simple-to-use, easy-to-read Instant Multi-function coffee maker control panel.



Your Multi-function coffee maker

Plugging in your Multi-function coffee maker

Before you plug in your Multi-function coffee maker, make sure your Multi-function coffee maker is on a dry, stable, and level surface. Once the Multi-function coffee maker is plugged in, press the power button, located above the **Bold** button. Your device is now in Function Selection mode. From here, you can begin brewing. See page 13 for brewing instructions.

To turn off the Multi-function coffee maker, press the **Power Button**.

After 30 minutes of inactivity, your coffee maker will enter standby mode. The LED control panel will dim. After another 2 hours of inactivity, the LED panel will shut off.

Sound Settings

You can turn button-pressing sounds and reminder beeps on or off.

1. Make sure your Instant Multi-function coffee maker is on.
2. Press and hold the **4 oz** and **6 oz** espresso buttons at the same time for 3 seconds.
3. Wait for the **4 oz** and **6 oz** buttons to blink twice. *To turn button-pressing sounds on, repeat the above instructions – the **4 oz** and **6 oz** buttons will blink three times.*

Note: The device failure sound cannot be deactivated

Altitude Mode

If you're using the Instant Multi-function coffee maker at +5,000 feet sea level, enable **Altitude Mode** before you brew.

To turn **Altitude Mode** on

1. Make sure your Instant Multi-function coffee maker is on.
2. Press and hold the **8 oz** and **10 oz** buttons at the same time for 3 seconds.
3. Wait until the **8 oz** and **10 oz** buttons blink three times.

Your Multi-function coffee maker

To turn **Altitude Mode** off

1. Make sure your Instant Multi-function coffee maker is on.
2. Press and hold the **8 oz** and **10 oz** buttons at the same time for 3 seconds.
3. Wait until the **8 oz** and **10 oz** buttons blink twice.

Low water alert

While or after brewing, your coffee maker will notify you the water tank is nearly empty. If this happens during a brewing cycle, the Water LED on the control panel will start flashing and the brewing program will continue.

While in this low water state, both the Water LED and Power button will remain lit. You cannot run another brewing program until you add water to the tank.

Adding water

1. Either remove the water tank from the coffee maker or leave the tank on the unit.
2. Fill the water tank with clean, cold water.
3. Place the water tank back onto the coffee maker or close the water tank lid.
4. Begin brewing your next cup of coffee.

You must add water before brewing your next cup of coffee.

DO NOT operate this coffeemaker without water in the water tank.

Before you brew

Initial set up

1. Pull the Instant Multi-function coffee maker and all accessories out of the box.
2. Remove all packaging materials from within and around the Instant Multi-function coffee maker.
3. Place your Multi-function coffee maker on a dry, stable, and level surface.
4. Place water tank back on the coffee maker base.
5. Plug in your Instant Multi-function coffee maker.

Clean before use

1. Handwash the water tank and reusable coffee pod with warm water and dish soap. Rinse with warm, clear water.
2. Lift the water tank up and remove the foam cushion from underneath the water tank. Stickers on the water tank may be removed.
3. Place the water tank back on the base and press down to secure it.
4. Wipe the water tank and accessories with a clean, dry cloth.
5. With a damp cloth, wipe down the coffee maker base and control panel.

Before you brew

Initial Cleaning

Before you brew your first cup of coffee, clean your Instant Multi-function coffee maker. Run the following cleaning program without a coffee pod or the reusable coffee pod.

1. Lift the water tank from the back of the coffee maker and remove the water tank lid.
2. Fill the water tank with cold water to the **MAX** fill line as indicated on the water tank.
3. Put the lid back onto the water tanks and place the water tank back onto the coffee maker.
4. Place a large mug which can hold at least 10 oz of liquid beneath the brew spout and onto the drip tray.
5. Close the brewing lid and ensure it's securely latched. Press **8 oz** button. The key flashes as the water heats.
6. The **8 oz** button will illuminate and the coffee maker begins a brewing cycle, and hot water will pour from the brew spout. After the brewing cycle ends or is cancelled and the water stops dripping from the spout, discard the water in the mug. *To **stop brewing at any time**, touch **8 oz** again.*
7. Place the mug back on the drip tray.
8. Touch **10 oz**. The button flashes as the water heats.
9. The **10 oz** button will illuminate and the coffee maker begins a brewing cycle, and hot water will pour from the brew spout. After the brewing cycle ends or is cancelled and the water stops dripping from the spout, discard the water in the mug. *To **stop brewing at any time**, touch **10 oz** again.*

Brewing Coffee

Brewing Coffee

Once you've cleaned your Instant Multi-function coffee maker and accessories, and you've run the initial cleaning program, you can begin brewing a delicious cup of coffee.

Bold

This program lets you brew a more flavorful cup of coffee by increasing brewing time, allowing the water to extract more flavor from a coffee pod or espresso pod.

Altitude Mode

If you live at higher altitudes (over 5,000 feet above sea level) be sure you follow these instructions, so your coffee maker works properly. See page 9 for instructions.

Coffee pods and espresso capsules

With the Instant® Multi-function coffee maker, you can brew coffee with a K-Cup® pod, espresso capsules or brew your favorite coffee grounds using the included reusable coffee pod.

Brewing Coffee

How to brew coffee

Prep

1. Fill the water tank up to the **MAX** fill line. ***DO NOT** attempt to brew if the water level is below the **MIN** fill line.*
2. Choose your favorite K-Cup* pod, espresso capsule, or fill the reusable coffee pod with two tablespoons of medium or medium-fine ground coffee.

Brew

1. Lift the latch to the brewing house.
2. Place your desired brewing pod into its appropriate inlet.
Close the brewing lid and ensure it is securely latched.
3. For a stronger cup of coffee, press **Bold** before selecting serving size.
4. Select the desired amount of coffee you would like to brew by pressing the **8 oz**, **10 oz** or **12 oz** buttons for coffee pods, or **4 oz**, **6 oz**, **8 oz** for espresso capsules. The selected button will flash while water heating cycle begins. *You can stop brewing at any time by pressing the selected cup size again.*
5. The selected brewing button will flash and remain illuminated when the coffee maker starts brewing. Soon, hot coffee will pour from the brew spout.
6. When the coffee stops dripping from the spout, remove your cup of coffee.

⚠ WARNING

Be careful: Brewing reaches high temperatures. **DO NOT** touch the brewing housing unit or spout during the brewing process. Touching hot surfaces may result in personal injury and/or property damage.

Care, Cleaning, Storage

Regularly clean your Instant Multi-function coffee maker and included accessories to ensure the best possible flavor and to prevent mineral deposits from building up in the coffee maker.

Always unplug the coffee maker and let it cool to room temperature before cleaning. Never use metal scouring pads, abrasive powders, or harsh chemical detergents on any of the coffee maker's parts.

Let all parts dry thoroughly before use, and before storage.

Instant Multi-function coffee maker Part/Accessory	Cleaning methods and instructions
Water tank	Remove the tank and handwash with dish soap and warm water.
Coffee pod holder	Remove and handwash with dish soap and warm water or place in the top rack of a dishwasher.
Stainless steel drip tray	Can be removed and washed by hand with dish soap and warm water or placed in the top rack of a dishwasher.
Coffee maker / LED panel	Use a damp dish cloth to clean the outside of the coffee maker and LED panel
Power cord	DO NOT fold power cord when storing.
Used pod container	Open the used pod container by folding down the cup support and pulling back on the cup support. Recycle the used pods. Holds up to 10 used pods at a time. Empty weekly, or more as needed. DO NOT allow pods to sit for longer than 7 days. Hand wash container with warm soapy water. Let air dry before placing back into the coffee maker.

⚠ WARNING

Be careful: The coffee maker contains electrical components.

To avoid fire, electric shock, or personal injury:

- Hand wash only.
- **DO NOT** rinse or immerse the coffee maker, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.

Care, Cleaning, Storage

Descaling / Removing Mineral Deposits

With regular use, mineral deposits may accumulate in the coffee maker, which can affect the temperature and strength of your brew.

To make sure your coffee maker stays in tip top shape, descale it regularly to keep minerals deposits from building up.

After 300 cycles, the 10 oz and 12 oz keys flash to remind you to clean and descale your coffee maker.

Descaling Solution Ratio

Cleaner	Cleaner to water ratio
Household descaler	1 : 4
Citric acid	3 : 100

1. Combine cleaner and water as shown in the table above.
2. Make sure the reusable pod is in the brewing housing unit.
3. Fill the water tank to the **MAX** line with the cleaning mixture.
4. Place a large container beneath the drip nozzle.
5. Touch and hold the **10 oz** and **12 oz** keys for 3 seconds. *The cleaning mixture runs through the appliance until the water tank is empty.*
6. Discard the cleaning mixture from the container and place the emptied container beneath the drip nozzle.
7. Rinse the water tank and fill to the **MAX** line with cool, clean water.
8. Touch and hold the **10 oz** and **12 oz** keys for 3 seconds. *The cleaning mixture runs through the appliance until the water tank is empty.*
9. Discard water produced from coffee maker.

⚠ WARNING

Be careful: Hot water is used for descaling. To avoid risk of personal injury and/or property damage, the container must be large enough to hold the **entire contents of the water tank** (68oz / 2000 mL).

Any other servicing should be performed by an authorized service representative.
