## Get the app

Download the free Arlo app to get started.

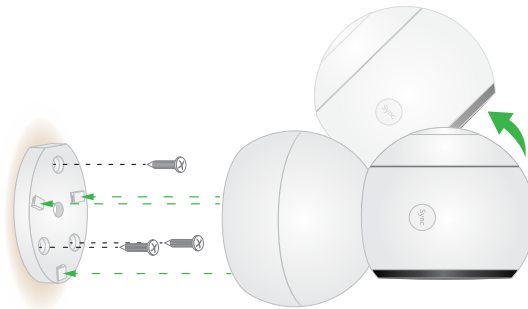
The app guides you through installation.



## Use the wall mount

You can place Arlo Baby on a flat surface or mount it on a wall.

1. Place the wall plate.
2. Secure the wall plate with the included screws.
3. Align the holes on the base of your camera with the wall plate.
4. Rotate the camera until the base snaps into place.



## Tilt and swivel

Position your camera so that it captures the area that you want to monitor.



## Start streaming

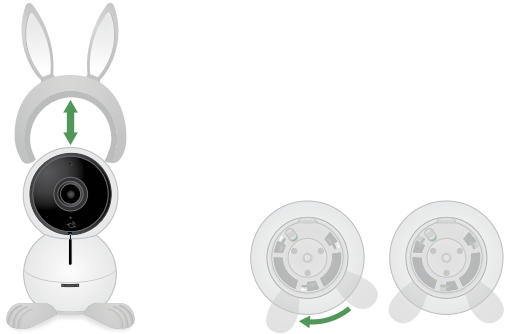

## Remove an Arlo Baby character set

Your Arlo Baby camera might come with a character set. You can remove the character set or replace it with other Arlo Baby characters.

1. Pull the character ears up to remove them.
2. Rotate the character feet and pull them off.



## Add an Arlo Baby character set

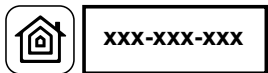
1. Align the ears with the camera lens and press them onto the camera.
2. Align the foot plate with the holes on the bottom of the camera and rotate the foot plate until it clicks into place.



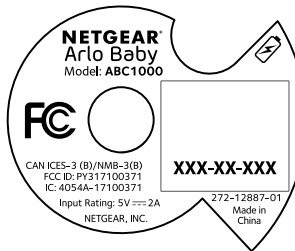
# Add Arlo Baby to the Apple Home app

1. Locate the HomeKit code.

The code is on the back cover of this guide and on the Arlo Baby camera label located on the bottom of the camera.

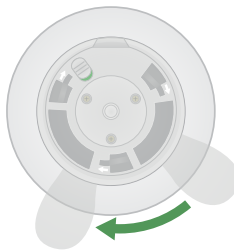


You can scan the HomeKit code on the back of this guide



You can type the HomeKit code that is on the Arlo Baby camera label

If you are using an Arlo Baby character, rotate the character feet and pull them off to see the HomeKit code on the label.



2. Launch the Apple Home app.
3. Tap the plus sign at the top of the page on the **Home** tab and then tap **Add Accessory**.

Your Apple mobile device's camera launches and you are prompted to scan or enter the HomeKit code.

4. Scan the HomeKit code using your mobile device's camera.  
If you have trouble scanning the code, tap **Don't Have a Code or Can't Scan?** and then type the code.
5. After your camera is added, do the following to complete the setup process:
  - Rename your camera.
  - Assign the camera to a room within HomeKit, or create a new room to place it in.
  - Add the camera to your Favorites.
6. Tap **Done** on the top right.

For live video, tap the Arlo Baby screen shot. To start using two-way audio, tap the microphone icon on the bottom right.

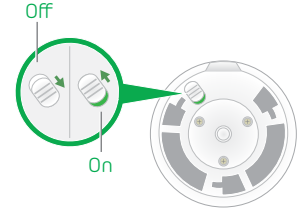

## Arlo Baby features

### ➤ Rechargeable battery

Your Arlo Baby camera includes a built-in rechargeable battery and can work for several hours at a time without being plugged in. You can place the camera in locations where you cannot connect it to a power outlet.

Use the switch on the bottom of the camera to power the Arlo Baby camera's battery off. The camera's battery is on when the green color is visible.



If the camera is unplugged and you don't want the battery to lose its charge, set the switch to Off.

### ➤ **Night light**

Use the app or the top button on the right side of the camera to turn the night light on and off.

### ➤ **Music**

Use the app or the bottom button on the right side of the camera to play and pause music.

### ➤ **Local streaming**

Enjoy minimal video lag by connecting your mobile device to the same WiFi network (SSID) as the one Arlo Baby is connected to.
