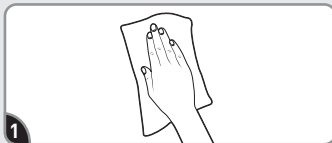

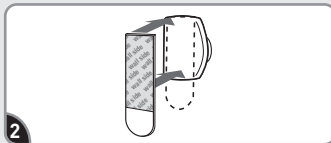

APPLY APLICAR



Works best on smooth surfaces. Apply to a clean and dry surface. To clean, use a dry cloth to remove dirt. Do not use household cleaners.

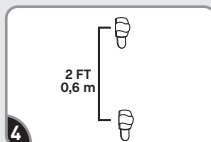
Separate strips. Remove blue liner. Press adhesive to clip.

Use one clip for every 2 feet of lights.

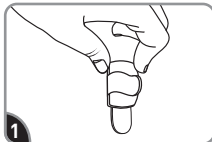

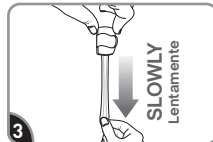
Gently hold clip in place.

If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter or replace the plug.

- l) Installing bulbs: Ensure that the base of the bulb is fully threaded into the socket by rotating clockwise. The base of the bulb should be sealer securely to the top of the socket.

Use and Care Instructions

- a) When the product is placed on a live tree, the tree should be well maintained and fresh. Do not place on live trees in which the needles are brown or break off easily. Keep the tree holder filled with water.
- b) If the product is placed on a tree, the tree should be well secured and stable.
- c) Before using or reusing, inspect product carefully. Discard any product that have cut, damaged or frayed wire insulation or cords, cracks in the lamp holders or enclosures, loose connections, or exposed copper wire.
- d) When storing the product, carefully remove the product from wherever it is placed, including trees, branches, or bushes, to avoid any undue strain or stress on the product conductors, connections and wires.
- e) When not in use, store neatly in a cool, dry location protected from sunlight.

User Servicing instructions

- Grasp plug and remove from the receptacle or other outlet device. Do not unplug by pulling on cord.
- Risk of fire. Do not replace attachment plug. Discard product if the attachment plug is damaged.
- Disconnect the lighting string or decorative outfit from the outlet before removing a lamp and replacing it with the ornament.
- This seasonal use product is not intended for permanent installation or use.
- Unscrew old bulb by rotating counterclockwise and removing from socket.
- Installing bulbs: Ensure that the base of the bulb is fully threaded into the socket by rotating clockwise. The base of the bulb should be sealer securely to the top of the socket.
- Unplug the product when leaving the house, or when retiring for the night, or if left unattended.
- This is an electric product – not a toy! To avoid risk of fire, burns, personal injury and electric shock it should not be played with or placed where small children can reach it.
- Do not use this product for other than its intended use.
- Do not hang ornaments or other objects from cord, wire, or light string.
- Replace bulb with only 120 Volt, 11 Watt S14 or G60 type bulb.

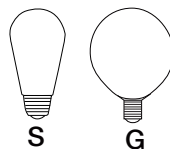

If connecting to a lighting string that does not have a Wattage (W) rating (found on the tag within 6 inches of the plug) calculate the wattage as follows: Multiply the current (___A) which is on the flag-type tag by 120.

For example: Lighting string is rated 120V, 60Hz, 0.2 Amps. $0.2 \times 120 = 24$ Watts. Add the wattage of each light string together for a total of 420 Watts or less.
(Do not exceed 420 Watts)

CAUTION

- To reduce the risk of fire use only type S14 or type G60 lamps, 11 watts maximum.



- To reduce the risk of fire do not deliberately reposition either lamp holder contact.
- To reduce the risk of fire and electric shock: a) Do not install on trees having needles, leave or branch coverings of metal or materials which look like metal. And b) Do not mount or support strings in a manner that can cut or damage wire insulation.

1 Year Limited Warranty

The Product is warranted against defects in materials and workmanship under normal use and service for a period of one (1) year from the date of original purchase when delivered to you in new condition in its original container. Warranty repair or replacement shall not extend the original warranty period of the Product. A dated proof of purchase is required at the time of warranty service. A copy of your dated bill of sale will satisfy this requirement. This warranty does not cover accessories or consumables, such as light bulbs, as to which there shall be no warranty or replacement.

This limited warranty covers all defects encountered in normal use of the Product and does not apply to the following cases:

1. 3. If the Product has had its model number or dating defaced, altered or removed.

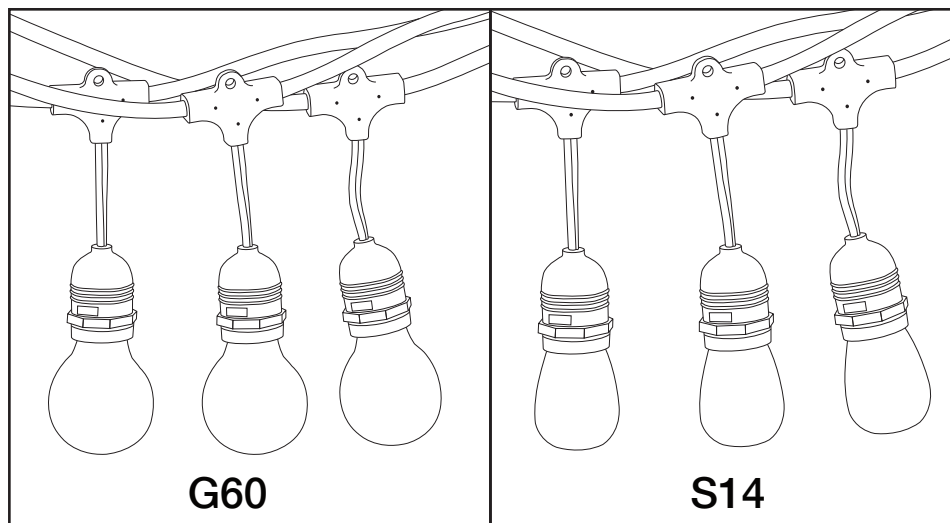

1. To reduce risk of electric shock, DO NOT connect or disconnect when wet.
2. DO NOT use with extension cord near water or where water may accumulate.
3. Keep lamps at least 16 feet (4.8m) from pools and spas
4. Keep plugs and receptacles dry; DO NOT submerge
5. When connecting multiple sets, protect connections from direct exposure to rain and water. DO NOT allow connection to become wet.
6. Lighting strings are rated for 120V, 60 Hz; DO NOT EXCEED 1560 total watts, all string combined. Do not connect more than nine (9) 48-Foot strings together or exceed 135 total bulbs.
7. Female connector is to be used ONLY for additional light sets.

INSTALLATION

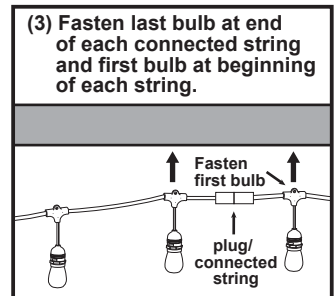
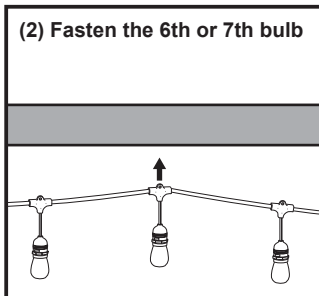
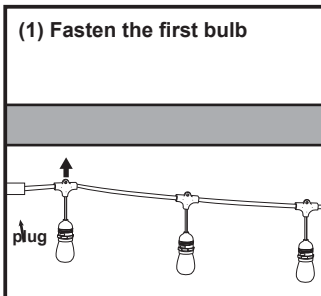
(Hardware, hooks, cable ties and guiding wire are not included.)

⚠️ CAUTION:

1. DO NOT secure cords with staples or nails.
2. If changing to a new location, remove bulbs before installation.
3. INSPECT set up and product condition before each use.
4. Keep bulbs at least 3 inches from other objects.

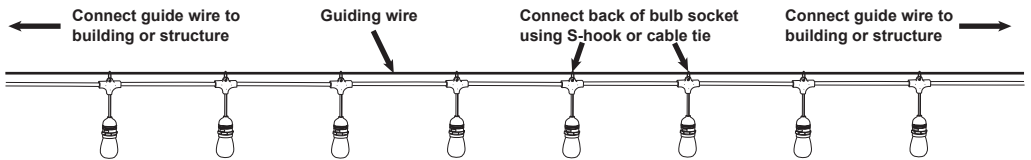
Installation without guide wire:

Ensure the String Light is securely fastened to a building or structure in three locations: (1) the first bulb, (2) The 6th or 7th bulb, and (3) the last bulb/the end of EACH connected String Light.

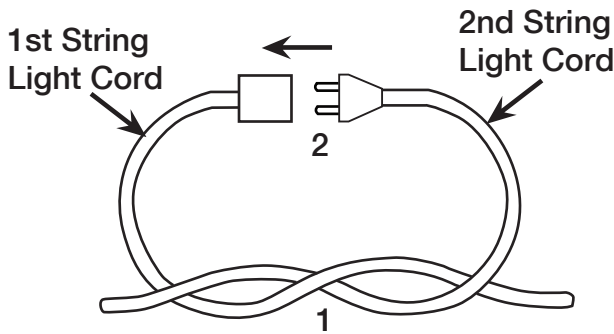


Installation with guide wire:

If you are installing the String Lights using a guide wire, use an S-hook or cable tie and connect every bulb backing to the guide wire using the hole located on the top of the socket.



⚠ NOTICE: When connecting multiple cords together, create a knot with the cord ends as shown below or use a plug protector to prevent the plugs from pulling apart during use.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Clean String Light only with a dry, soft cloth. Do NOT use abrasive cleaners.

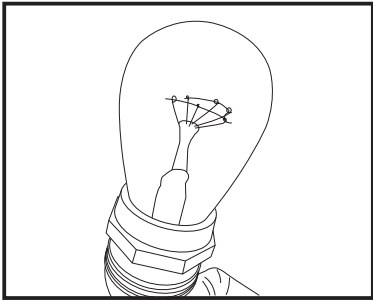
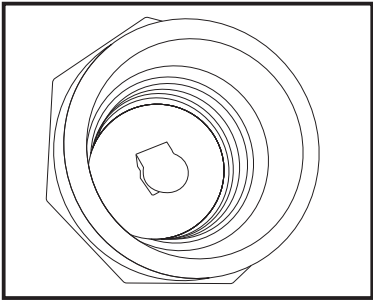
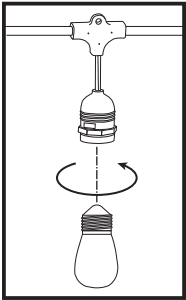
Issue	Possible Source	Resolution
Light did not come on initially or no longer comes on.	1. Bulb is burnt out/damaged 2. Bulb is not properly installed 3. String Light is not plugged in	1. Replace bulb 2. Reinstall bulb 3. Plug String Light into outlet

INSTALLING/REPLACING LIGHT BULBS

⚠ WARNING: To prevent serious injury, unplug String Light from electrical outlet before installing/replacing bulbs. Please allow bulb to cool down before touching.

Installing Bulbs:

1. Grasp plug and remove from the receptacle or other outlet device. Do not unplug by pulling on cord.
2. Unscrew old bulb by rotating counterclockwise and removing from socket.
3. Install new bulb. Ensure that the base of the bulb is fully threaded into the socket by rotating clockwise. The base of the bulb should be sealed securely to the top of the socket. This will prevent moisture from entering the socket.



⚠ WARNING: Ensure that your replacement bulb fits securely into the bulb socket. Incorrectly fitting bulbs will not seal socket properly and may cause injury or death from shattered glass or electric shock.

Replacing Bulbs:

Prior to purchase of replacement bulbs, please make sure to meet the below specifications. S14 and G60 replacement bulbs may be available at local hardware stores or on Amazon.com.
