


Exploded View




Step 1- Unfold Frame

Carefully remove Base Frame from carton, and unfold. Insert safety pin(26) into right side of frame

Note Front, Rear, Right and Left Sides for further assembly



Step 2- Handlebar Assembly




STEP 2 (Cont)

Attach the Handlebar Right (08) to the Base frame Rear(01) using 2 Bolts (13), 2 Washers (20), and 2 Nuts (22). Use Bolt (11) and Flat Washer (20) to fix the Base frame Rear(01) .Repeat for Handlebar Left (02) except there will not be a part 11 or 20 for this side.

<u>TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS AT THIS TIME</u>

Step 3- Backrest Assembly to Base Frame




STEP 3 Connecting Backrest Pad & Assembly to Frame

Attach the Completed Backrest Pad Assembly to the Base frame Unit using Bolts (15), Flat Washers (20) and Lock Nuts (22) as shown


NOTE: TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS AT THIS TIME

STEP 4 -Body Height Adjustment Tube and Rollers

A- Install Foot Rest Plate (6) into Height Adjustment Tube (4) using Hexagonal Bolts (17), & Flat Washers (20)




B- Lift out front roller tube (31) from Height
Adjustment Selector Tube (5) and position as shown. Slide Foam Rollers (42) over front Tube (5) and insert Plastic End Caps (34)



<u>C</u>- Insert Rear Foam Roller Tube (7) through Height Adjustment Tube (4) and secure with Bolt (16), Metal Spacer (25), Washer (20) and nut (22). Slide Foam Rollers (42) over Rear Tube (7) and insert End Caps (34). Make sure Leg Tube Adjustment Knob (31) is properly connected to Height Adjustment Tube (4) and functions properly

TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS AT THIS TIME

STEP 5 -Final Assembly




Slide Completed Height Adjustment Tube and Foot Rest Assembly (4) into Backrest Support Tube (3) and lock into place using Height Adjustment Knob (30) and Safety Pin (27)

Note: This product is designed with a Maximum User Weight of 300 LBS.

NOTE: TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS AT THIS TIME

Heat / Massage Pad and Head Pad Assembly to Backrest Pad



Step 6 Connecting Head Pad and Heat/Massage Lumbar Pad

Attach the Heat / Massage Lumbar Pad(48) and the Head Pad(45) to Backrest Pad(47) in Desired Position using Velcro. Controller(46) can be stored in Right Side Pocket of Backrest Pad(44) for easy access.

Note: Please pay careful attention that the power cord is not squeezed or damaged by the inversion table when using it.

Final Assembly

Make Sure All Nuts Bolts and Screws are Completely Tightened Before Use.

Controller Instruction

HEAT & MASSAGE PAD USER INSTRUCTIONS



POWER-HEAT BUTTON

Press it to activate the power to the Lumbar pad. This is an automatic mode lasting 10 minutes. After 10 minutes, the unist will automatically shut off. It features massage mode-1" and intensity level-1".

In order to deactivate the Lumbar pad, please press and hold the Power Heat button for at least 2 seconds.

MODE BUTTON

Press it to choose one of the 2 available massage modes.

With every press of the Mode button, the diplay will consecutively show the numbers A1. A2

INTENSITY BUTTON

Press it to choose one of the 3 available massage intensity levels. With every press of the **INTENSITY** button, the diplay will consecutively show the numbers 1-3.

TIME BUTTON

Every session lasts a maximum of 10 minutes. Press the Time button to adjust the massaging time (5 or 10 minutes).

Switching the device on and off frequently is not advised.

USAGE GUIDELINES



INVERSION SELECTOR PIN

Familiarize yourself with the Inversion Selector Pin located on the Right Side of the Inversion Table. The positioning of the pin will determine the degree of Inversion that you are comfortable with.

The 3 selections are:

20- Slight Inversion

40-Moderate Inversion

60- Enhanced Inversion

NOTE: IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT SOMEONE BE WITH YOU DURING INVERSION. ALTHOUGH THE INVERSION TABLE IS EASY TO USE, HAVING SOMEONE NEARBY TO "SPOT" YOU WILL PROVIDE EXTRA SAFETY AND SUPPORT TO THE INVERSION PROCESS. START WITH 20 DEGREE SETTING

Body Height Adjustment:

Before Starting, insure that the Inversion Table is at the correct settings to match your height. (This is indicated on the Height Adjustment Selector in both Inches and Centimeters.

As each individual's body type is different, you will need to find the correct balance settings for your specific body type by adjusting the selector up or down to obtain the proper balance

USAGE GUIDELINES- Securing Feet and Ankles

WARNING: ALWAYS WEAR ATHLETIC SHOES WITH LACES TIGHT TO HELP SECURE YOUR FEET IN THE INVERSION SYSTEM, AND FOR FOOT PROTECTION WHILE EXERCISING.

ALWAYS MAKE SURE THAT THE ANKLE LOCK IS SECURED SNUGLY AGAINST YOUR ANKLES AND THAT THE LONG KNOB IS FULLY TIGHTENED BEFORE YOU USE THE INVERSION SYSTEM

Step 1- Expand the front rollers by pulling up on the Leg Tube Adjustment Knob (31)



<u>Step 2-</u> Slide Feet under Foam Rollers



Step 3- Contract the front rollers snugly over feet by releasing the Leg Tube Adjustment Knob and making sure it "Locks" into place.



<u>WARNING:</u> LEGS AND ANKLES MUST BE SUCURELY LOCKED INTO PLACE BEFORE INVERTING. <u>DO NOT INVERT</u> IF THIS LOCKING MECHANISM IS NOT FUNCTIONING PROPERLY

USAGE GUIDELINES



Finding the Proper Height and Weight Adjustment

With head flat on back pad, slowly raise one arm up toward the ceiling. If the bed starts to invert backward, the height adjustment should be correct.

If the bed does not start to invert, adjust the center slider arm upward one position at a time, until the bed starts to invert backward. Remember to use very slow arm movements.



By raising both hands over your head, the Inversion Table should now invert to a greater degree, provided that you are comfortable with the side adjustment knob being set to 20 or higher.

Note: It is recommended that beginners use the setting marked 20 for Partial Inversion.



With proper supervision, and provided you are comfortable with the side adjustment knob being set to 40 or 60, the Inversion Table will now allow for a more complete Inversion position.

CAUTION: BY LOWERING THE HANDS BACK TO THE STARTING POSITION, THE INVERSION TABLE SHOULD REVERT BACK TO THE UPRIGHT POSITION. IF IT DOES NOT, USE THE BUILT IN SIDE HANDLEBARS TO PULL YOURSELF BACK UP AND RE-ADJUST THE CENTER SLIDER TO ACCOMMODATE YOUR BODY WEIGHT AND TYPE.
