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Safety Instructions



Read these instructions carefully and retain them for future use. If this Smart Matter Plug is passed to a third party, then these instructions must be included.

When using Smart Matter Plugs, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons including the following:

⚠ WARNING

- ▶ The total current limit of the device is 15 amps. To avoid damage, do not exceed the 15-amp limit. If a direct short is created on the output, the Smart Matter Plug will be damaged and no longer function.
- ▶ Do not disassemble the product or make repairs yourself. You run the risk of electric shock and voiding the limited warranty. If you need service, please contact customer service.
- ▶ Make sure to use this product together with a 15A circuit breaker or fuse in the upstream circuit.
- ▶ The applicable requirements must be observed during installation. Failure to observe the requirements may result in damage to property and/or injury, or even danger of death.
- ▶ Observe the technical data, in particular the maximum permissible switching power of the relay and the type of product to be connected, before connecting a product. All load information relates to ohmic loads. The device should only be loaded to the specified power limit. Overloading may result in destruction of the device, fire, or an electrical accident. Among other things, reliable switching off of the connected product cannot be guaranteed.
- ▶ Devices with electronic power supplies (for example, televisions or high voltage LED lights) do not constitute an ohmic load. They may generate start-up currents of more than 100A. Switching such products results in premature wear on the integrated relay. As a result, it is possible that the connected product may not reliably switch off.
- ▶ Do not connect devices which can cause fires or other damage if switched on unsupervised (for example, irons).
- ▶ Always unplug the device from the Smart Matter Plug before making changes to the device.

- ▶ Do not use the Smart Matter Plug with power strips or with extension cables.
- ▶ Do not use the Smart Matter Plug for disconnection. The load is not electrically isolated from the mains.
- ▶ Do not plug Smart Matter Plugs into one another.
- ▶ The Smart Matter Plug is only de-energized when it is removed from the socket.

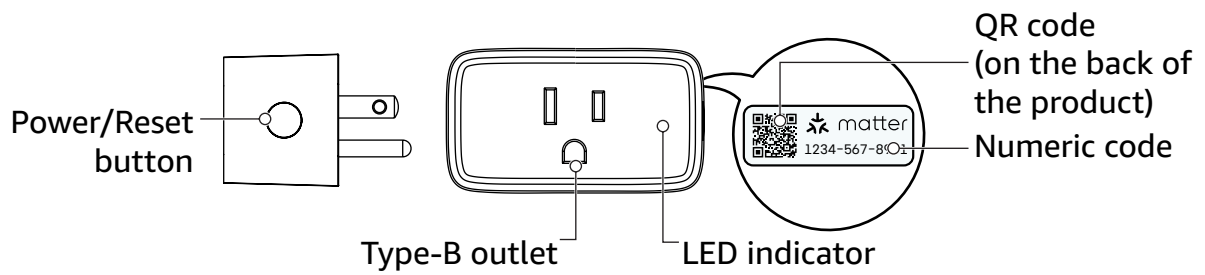

Set Up the Smart Matter Plug

NOTICE: Before setting up, make sure you have a Matter-compatible smart home app and devices.

You can set up the Smart Matter Plug with the QR code on the back of your printed *Quick Setup Guide* (recommended) or on the back of the product. You can also set it up with the numeric code below the QR code.

The following section explains how to connect to Amazon Alexa, Google Home, and Apple Home. For the most up-to-date instructions, please refer to each platform's official website.

Connect to Alexa/Amazon

1. Launch the Alexa app and go to the Device page.
2. Tap **+**, then **Add Device** to add a new device.
3. Scroll down to the bottom, tap **Other**, then tap *** Matter**.
4. Tap **Yes** on the confirming page.
5. Tap **Scan QR Code**, then scan the QR code on the side of the device. A paper QR code is also provided in the *Quick Setup Guide*.

OR

Tap **Try Numeric Code Instead?**, then enter the numeric code that comes with your device.

6. Wait for your device to set up, then choose the Wi-Fi you want your device to connect to and enter the corresponding Wi-Fi password.
Notice: Connect the device to the same WiFi your Echo device is connected to.
7. Tap **Done**. Now you can find your device on the device list and use your Alexa to control your device.

Connect to Google Home/Google

1. Launch the Google Home app and go to the Devices page.
2. Tap **Add Device**, then tap **Matter-enabled device**.
3. Tap **Scan code**, then scan the QR code on the side of the device. A paper QR code is also provided in the *Quick Setup Guide*.
4. Tap **I agree** on the "Connect this device to your Google Account" page, then tap **Add to Google Home**.
5. The "Accessory Name" setting page is displayed. Choose a location for your device, then give it a name. Now you can find your device on the device list and use your Google Home to control your device.

Connect to Apple Home/Apple

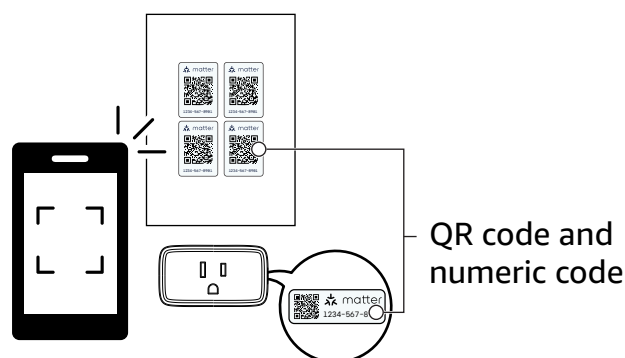
1. Launch the Apple Home App, then tap **+** in the top right corner on the homepage, then tap **Add or Scan Accessory**.
2. Tap **Add or Scan Accessory**, then scan the QR code on the side of your device. A paper QR code is also provided in the *Quick Setup Guide*.
3. Choose a location for your device, then give it a name.
4. Choose how your device will appear. Now you can find your device on the device list and use your Apple Home to control your device.

Alternative Setup Methods

1. Download the latest version of the Alexa app or a Matter-compatible smart home app, then log in.
2. Plug in the Amazon Basics Smart Matter Plug.
3. In the Alexa app, tap **More** to add a device, then select **Plug, Amazon Basics, and Smart Matter Plug**.
4. Follow the steps in the app to complete setup. When prompted, tap **Scan QR Code**, then scan the QR code on the *Quick Setup Guide* or on the plug.

OR

Tap **Try Numeric Code Instead?**, then enter the 11-digit number below the QR code and follow the on-screen instructions to complete setup.



Understanding the LED

Indicator	Description
LED lights red for 1 minute	Smart Matter Plug is unregistered
LED blinks red quickly for 1 minute	Smart Matter Plug is disconnected
LED lights green for 3 seconds	Smart Matter Plug is connected
LED blinks red and green alternately	Smart Matter Plug is reset to factory defaults
LED blinks green rapidly for 5 minutes	Smart Matter Plug is ready for setup
LED blinks green slowly for 5 minutes	Smart Matter Plug is being added to another assistant or app
LED is off	Smart Matter Plug is off

Using the Smart Matter Plug

- ▶ Press the power/reset button to turn the Smart Matter Plug (and connected device) on or off.
- ▶ Use the app to turn the Smart Matter Plug on/off remotely, set schedules, and more.
- ▶ Use the voice control on your Amazon Alexa, Google Home, or Apple Home app. For example, you can say, "Alexa, turn on First Plug."

Reset to Factory Defaults

Press and hold the power/reset button for 10 seconds until the indicator blinks red and green alternately.

Troubleshooting

If the Smart Matter Plug is not functioning properly, try the following solutions.

Problem

My Smart Matter Plug won't connect to Alexa.

Solutions

- ▶ Make sure that you have correctly added the Echo device before pairing.
- ▶ Make sure that your Echo and the Alexa App are updated to the latest software version.
- ▶ Move your phone/tablet closer to your Smart Matter Plug.
- ▶ Make sure that your Echo and Smart Matter Plug are connected to the same 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network. The Smart Matter Plug is not compatible with 5GHz networks.
- ▶ If you have a dual Wi-Fi router and both network signals have the same name, rename one and try reconnecting to the 2.4GHz network.
- ▶ Make sure you scan the correct 2D barcode provided in your *Quick Setup Guide* or on the Smart Matter Plug.
- ▶ If you have more than one Smart Matter Plug and are scanning the 2D barcode in your *Quick Setup Guide*, match the DSN number on the Smart Matter Plug to the 2D barcode.
- ▶ Restart your device by powering it off and on, then set up again.
- ▶ Factory reset your Smart Matter Plug. See "Reset to Factory Defaults" on page 6.

Problem

My connected device won't turn on/off with the app.

Solutions

- ▶ Make sure that the device connected to the Smart Matter Plug is turned on. For example, if you connected a lamp, turn the lamp's power switch to the "on" position.
- ▶ Make sure that your Echo and Smart Matter Plug are connected to the same Wi-Fi network.
- ▶ Restart your device by powering it off and on, and then try again.
- ▶ Reset your Smart Matter Plug to factory defaults, then set up the Smart Matter Plug with the app again, see "Set Up the Smart Matter Plug" on page 4.

Problem

I can't change my Smart Matter Plug settings.

Solutions

- ▶ Restart your device by powering it off and on, and then try again.
- ▶ Reset your Smart Matter Plug to factory defaults, then set up the Smart Matter Plug with the app again. See "Set Up the Smart Matter Plug" on page 4.

Problem

If I lose the *Quick Setup Guide*, how can I set up my Smart Matter Plug?

Solutions

- ▶ You can set up your device via two alternative setup methods. The instructions can be found in "Alternative Setup Methods" on page 6.

Problem

Alexa error code displays on the screen.

Solutions

- ▶ Make sure your phone has Bluetooth turned on throughout the entire setup process and the device you are trying to setup is in pairing mode.
- ▶ Make sure that your Echo and Smart Matter Plug are connected to the same 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network. The Smart Matter Plug is not compatible with 5GHz networks.
- ▶ Restart your device by powering it off and on, and then set up again.
- ▶ Factory reset your Smart Matter Plug. See "Reset to Factory Defaults" on page 6.

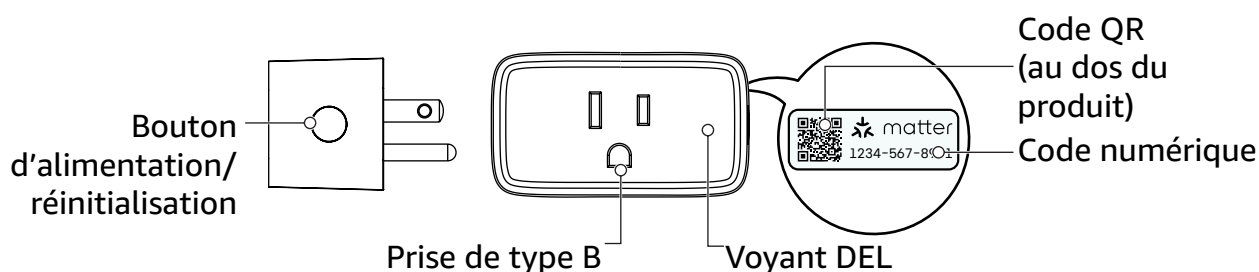

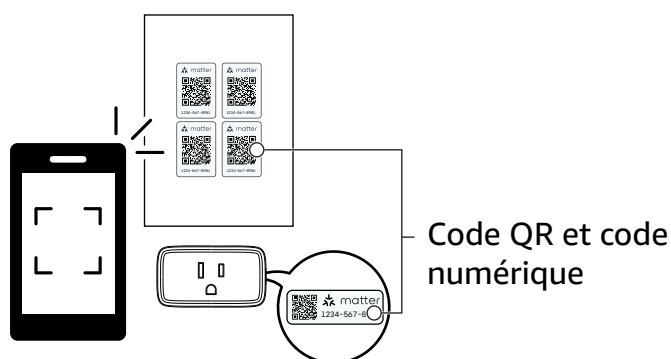

Utilisation de la prise Matter intelligente

- Appuyez sur le bouton d'alimentation/de réinitialisation pour allumer ou éteindre la prise Matter intelligente (et l'appareil connecté).
- Utilisez l'application pour allumer/éteindre la prise Matter intelligente à distance, définir des horaires et plus encore.
- Utilisez la commande vocale sur votre application Amazon Alexa, Google Home ou Apple Home. Par exemple, vous pouvez dire : « Alexa, allume la première prise ».

Rétablissement aux paramètres d'usine par défaut

Appuyez sur le bouton d'alimentation/de réinitialisation et maintenez-le enfoncé pendant 10 secondes jusqu'à ce que le voyant clignote alternativement en rouge et en vert.

Dépannage

Si la prise Matter intelligente ne fonctionne pas correctement, essayez les solutions suivantes.

Problème

Ma prise Matter intelligente ne se connecte pas à Alexa.

Solutions

- ▮ Assurez-vous d'avoir correctement ajouté l'appareil Echo avant de procéder au jumelage.
- ▮ Vérifiez que votre appareil Echo et l'application Alexa utilisent la version la plus récente du logiciel.
- ▮ Rapprochez votre téléphone/tablette de votre prise Matter intelligente.
- ▮ Assurez-vous que votre Echo et votre prise Matter intelligente sont connectés au même réseau Wi-Fi 2,4 GHz. La prise Matter intelligente n'est pas compatible avec les réseaux 5 GHz.
- ▮ Si vous avez un routeur Wi-Fi double bande et que les deux signaux réseau ont le même nom, renommez-en un et essayez de vous reconnecter au réseau 2,4 GHz.
- ▮ Assurez-vous de numériser le bon code-barres 2D fourni dans votre *Guide de configuration rapide* ou sur la prise Matter intelligente.
- ▮ Si vous avez plus d'une prise Matter intelligente et que vous numérisez le code-barres 2D figurant dans votre *Guide de configuration rapide*, associez le numéro DSN sur la prise Matter intelligente au code-barres 2D.
- ▮ Redémarrez votre appareil en l'éteignant et en le rallumant, puis reprenez la configuration.
- ▮ Réinitialisez votre prise Matter intelligente aux paramètres d'usine. Consultez « Rétablissement aux paramètres d'usine par défaut » à la page 16.

Problème

Mon appareil connecté ne s'allume pas/ne s'éteint pas avec l'application.

Solutions

- ▮ Assurez-vous que l'appareil connecté à la prise Matter intelligente est allumé. Par exemple, si vous avez connecté une lampe, mettez l'interrupteur de la lampe en position « allumée ».
- ▮ Assurez-vous que votre Echo et votre prise Matter intelligente sont connectés au même réseau Wi-Fi.
- ▮ Redémarrez votre appareil en l'éteignant et en le rallumant, puis réessayez.

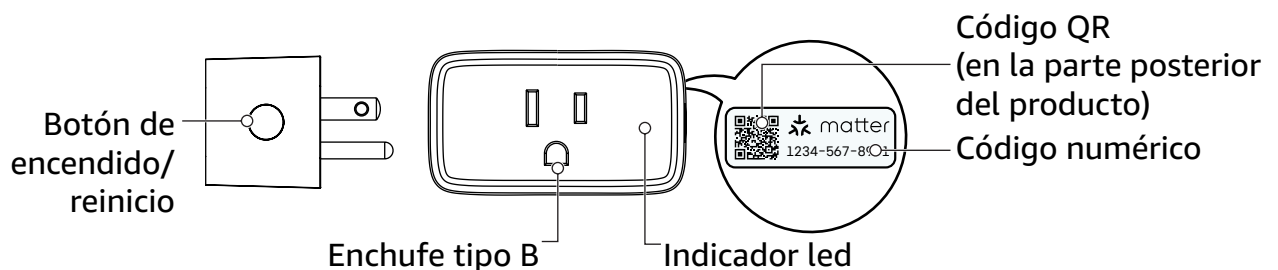

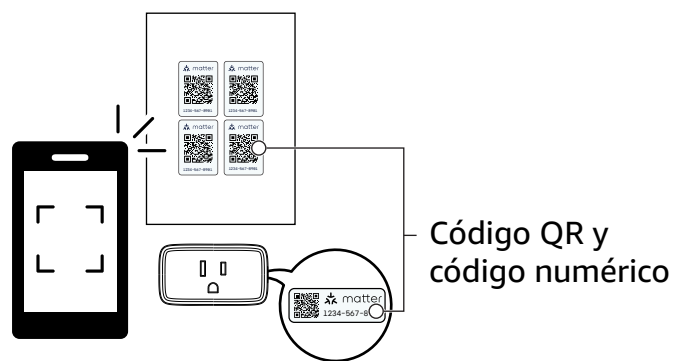
