

Question: I think my stats might have been altered by a hacker. Is there anything I can do?

Answer: When playing *Call of Duty: Modern Warfare* online, it is highly recommended that you play in Public Matches, or that you only play with players you know and trust when playing in Private Matches. Accepting Private Match invitations from players you don't know and trust might place you in a hacked lobby, which can leave you vulnerable to having your stats artificially padded, or boosted.

Please note: *Having your stats knowingly or unknowingly boosted by a hacker might lead to your stats being damaged beyond restoration, and might also be grounds for a ban.*

Call of Duty: Modern Warfare marks the return of Special Ops, a collection of expansive, interconnected Operations that pick up where the Campaign story concludes, and Missions that challenge individual skills and abilities. As part of a joint force of Allegiance and Coalition operators led by Kate Laswell (CIA) and Sergeant Kamarov (FSB), you and your squad mates must stop and sever a global terror organization's access to weapons, funds, intelligence, and hardware.

Special Ops is available to all players on all platforms at launch.

Question: How can I report a player in *Call of Duty: Modern Warfare*?

Answer: If you suspect that a player is cheating, or you feel a player is using language or a customization that you find offensive, you can report the player within the game.

To report a player from the Multiplayer menu:

1. Press **Y (Xbox)** or **△ (PlayStation)** to open the Social menu, or select the **Social** tab on PC.
2. Select **Recent Players**.
3. Highlight the player you wish to report and press **A (Xbox)** or **X (PlayStation)**, or select the player on PC.
4. Select **Report Player**.
5. Choose one of the available options.

Please note: *If you choose to report a player who is on your Friends list, be sure to remove that player from your Friends list.*

We take these issues very seriously, and we appreciate your bringing cheaters and offensive players to our attention. Your report will be reviewed, and we will take appropriate actions if

necessary. *Due to confidentiality, we cannot provide updates or actions taken as a result of your report.*

Below is Infinity Ward's posted Security & Enforcement Policy for *Call of Duty: Modern Warfare*. All infractions undergo a thorough review process by the Infinity Ward security team before enforcement, and penalties are not subject to further review.

Definitions

A **minor offense** is one in which no quantifiable damage has been done to another player or the game community at large.

Temporary suspensions can range from 48 hours to two weeks or longer, depending on the severity of the infraction.

Permanent suspensions are lasting and final.

An **extreme offense** is one in which a player has caused detriment to other players or has organized large groups of players to commit additional offenses.

Use of Unauthorized Third Party Software for Modding/Hacking

Any user who utilizes unauthorized third-party software to gain an unfair advantage, manipulate stats, and/or manipulate game data is subject to penalty. Unauthorized third-party software includes, but is not limited to, aimbots, wallhacks, trainers, stats hacks, texture hacks, leaderboard hacks, injectors, or any other software used to deliberately modify game data on disk or in memory.

- **First offense:** User will be permanently suspended from playing the game online, will have their stats, emblems, and weapon customizations reset, and will be blocked permanently from appearing in leaderboards.
 - **Console users** who modify their hardware or profile data will also be reported to console manufacturers.
 - **PC users** on Battle.net will be reported to the Battle.net enforcement team.

Pirated Content

Any user who illegally acquires *Call of Duty: Modern Warfare* content is subject to penalty.

- **First offense:** User will be permanently suspended from playing the game online, will have their stats, emblems, and weapon customizations reset, and will be blocked permanently from appearing in leaderboards.
 - **Console users** in possession of illegally acquired content will also be reported to console manufacturers.
 - **PC users** on Battle.net will be reported to the Battle.net enforcement team.

Unsupported Peripheral Devices and Applications

Any user who utilizes an unsupported external hardware device or application to interact with the game and use for cheating is subject to penalty. Unsupported peripheral devices and applications include, but are not limited to, modded controllers, IP flooders, and lag switches.

- **Minor offense:** User will be temporarily suspended from playing the game online, will have their stats and emblems reset and will have their leaderboard entries deleted.
- **Extreme or repeat offenses:** User will be permanently suspended from playing the game online, will have their stats and emblems reset, and will be blocked permanently from appearing in leaderboards.

Boosting

Any user who colludes with another user to exploit the game for the purpose of gaining XP, prestige, game score, weapon level, or in-game unlock is subject to penalty.

- **First offense:** User will be temporarily suspended from playing the game online, will have their stats, emblems, and weapon customizations reset, and will have their leaderboard entries deleted.
- **Extreme or repeat offenses:** User will be permanently suspended from playing the game online, will have their stats, emblems, and weapon customizations reset, and will be blocked permanently from appearing in leaderboards.

Glitching

Any user who abuses an exploit in game code or other established rule of play is subject to penalty. An example includes, but is not limited to, using a hole in the map geo to intentionally go outside of the map boundary.

- **First offense:** User will be temporarily suspended from playing the game online, will have their stats, emblems, and weapon customizations reset, will have online split-screen privileges revoked, and will have their leaderboard entries deleted.

- **Extreme or repeat offenses:** User will be permanently suspended from playing the game online, will have their stats, emblems, and weapon customizations reset, and will be blocked permanently from appearing in leaderboards.

Griefing

Any user who purposefully prevents another player from playing the game as intended by exploit or repeated unsportsmanlike behavior, such as intentional friendly fire, is subject to penalty.

- **First offense:** User will be temporarily suspended from playing the game online with teammates, will have their stats, emblems, and weapon customizations reset, and will have their leaderboard entries deleted.
- **Extreme or repeat offenses:** User will be permanently suspended from playing the game online, will have their stats, emblems, and weapon customizations reset, and will be blocked permanently from appearing in leaderboards.

Offensive Behavior

Any user who is found to use aggressive, offensive, derogatory, or culturally charged language is subject to penalty. Cyber-bullying and other forms of harassment are considered extreme offenses and will result in the harshest penalty.

- **First offense:** User will be temporarily suspended from playing the game online.
- **Second offense:** User will be temporarily suspended from playing the game online and will have party privileges in the game revoked.
- **Extreme or repeat offenses:** User will be permanently suspended from playing the game online, will have their stats, emblems, and weapon customizations reset, and will be blocked permanently from appearing in leaderboards.

Improperly Obtained Downloadable/Unlockable Content

Users that are found to have inventories containing content obtained outside of normal gameplay are subject to penalty. Penalties will not be issued for content obtained by gifting, social means, customer service intervention, and/or promotional events.

- **First offense:** Users will be temporarily suspended from using the inventory system, and a full inventory reset will be issued.
- **Extreme or repeat offenses:** Users will be permanently suspended from using the inventory system and a full inventory reset issued.

Decompiling or Reverse Engineering of Game Data

Any user who is found to be decompiling or reverse engineering game code or data on disk or in memory is subject to penalty. To "Decompile" or "Reverse Engineer" the software is a breach of EAULA section 3 condition 7. "You agree that you will not do, or allow, any of the following:...

(7) subject to applicable laws, reverse engineer, derive source code, modify, decompile, disassemble, or create derivative works of the software."

- **First offense:** User will be permanently suspended from playing the game online, will have their stats reset, and will be blocked permanently from appearing in leaderboards.
 - **Console users** who modify their hardware or profile data will also be reported to console manufacturers.
 - **PC users** on Battle.net will be reported to the Battle.net enforcement team.

Question: My *Call of Duty: Modern Warfare* stats and rank are lower than where they were the last time I played. What happened?

Answer: If your stats and rank become altered or modified outside of normal game mechanics, the *Call of Duty* servers will attempt to restore them using the most recently stored backup. This means that your stats and rank might not be exactly where they were before the reset occurred.

Question: What might have caused this?

Answer: Stats and rank issues can occur for a variety of reasons, including:

- **Playing on a Wi-Fi connection** — Wireless connections tend to be unstable and can lead to data loss.
- **Playing on a shared connection** — Data loss can occur over shared connections, such as institutional (school) or corporate networks.
- **Quitting matches early** — Data is routinely stored after each match. Leaving a match early can negatively impact data being saved from previous matches.
- **Exiting the game early** — Leaving the game before a Public Match is complete could impact data from previous matches.
- **Playing in Private Matches with players you don't know** — Accepting Private Match invitations from players you don't know can unknowingly enter you into a hacked lobby and/or leave you susceptible to corruption or loss of data.

Question: How can I ensure this doesn't happen?

Answer: Here are some best practices to protect your rank and stats:

- Always play Public Matches over a wired connection.
- Avoid playing on a shared connection.
- Always complete Public Matches.
- Only play Private Matches with players you know and trust.

Question: Is there any way to restore my rank and stats to their previous state?

Answer: Select your platform to contact us and request to have corrupted rank or stats restored.

The recommended driver version for *Call of Duty: Modern Warfare* is **Game Ready Driver 440.97**. Bug fixes and optimizations have been done specifically for this version.

On Windows 7, driver version **Game Ready Driver 419.00** or above is required, though Game Ready Driver 440.97 is still recommended.

AMD

The recommended driver version for *Call of Duty: Modern Warfare* is **Radeon Software version 19.10.2**.

Intel

Intel Integrated GPUs are not supported in *Call of Duty: Modern Warfare*.

Question: I received an error message saying that my video card drivers are out of date. How can I update my drivers?

Answer: One of the first things you should do when a game is having problems is ensuring that your computer's drivers and operating system are up to date. Out-of-date drivers and operating systems can lead to several issues that can negatively affect game performance.

A few things to note:

- Even new computers can have out-of-date drivers and operating systems because updates are released routinely.
- Some games and programs might run fine on a system with old drivers, but outdated drivers can still create technical issues with specific games or programs.

How do I update my video card drivers?

1. Press **Windows + R**.
2. Type "DxDiag" and click **OK**.
3. After the DirectX Diagnostic Tool loads, select the **Display** tab.
4. The video card's name and manufacturer are listed in the Device section. The current driver version is listed in the Driver section.
5. Visit the driver manufacturer's website to obtain the most up-to-date driver. Contact the driver manufacturer for assistance with updating the driver. If the computer is under warranty, contact the computer manufacturer.
