High Contrast Grey Projection Material

Care & Use

Proper care and use of the **CineGrey** will maximize the life of the material to bring you years of enjoyment.

Projection Side

The CineGrey material has a high contrast grey finish on the front and is black on the back. This black backing prevents light penetration from behind.

Material Maintenance

Wrinkles/Creases:

The material may have minor wrinkles which will get removed after stretching it over a frame or a mounting system that allows tensioning.

Dust/Dirt:

A feather duster should be used to remove loose dirt or dust. Use mild soap and warm water on a microfiber cloth to clean dirt or dust spots. Do not rub or scrape the material.

Quick Tip

For best picture quality results, maintain a minimum viewing distance if possible 1.5 times the width of your projection image. The CineGrey is designed for low contrast DLP and LCD Home Cinema Projectors. It enhances black levels while minimizing loss in color reproduction. *If your projector's contrast ratio is more than 2000:1, we recommend you use CineWhite material for a brighter picture,
