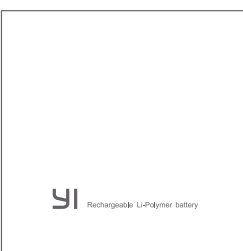

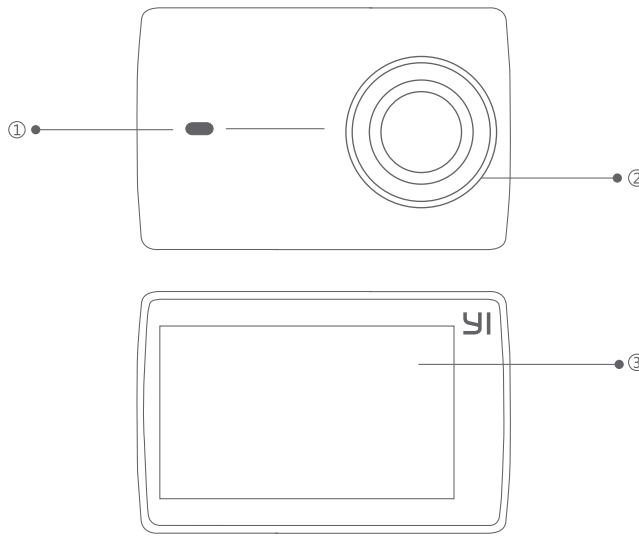

2.Getting to know the camera



- ① Battery charge status light
- ② Lens
- ③ LCD screen



- ④ Speaker
- ⑤ Power status light/Video status light
- ⑥ Power/Shutter button
- ⑦ Microphone
- ⑧ Battery cover
- ⑨ Selfie stick/Tripod socket
- ⑩ Micro USB port

3.Insert/Remove Micro SD card (sold separately)

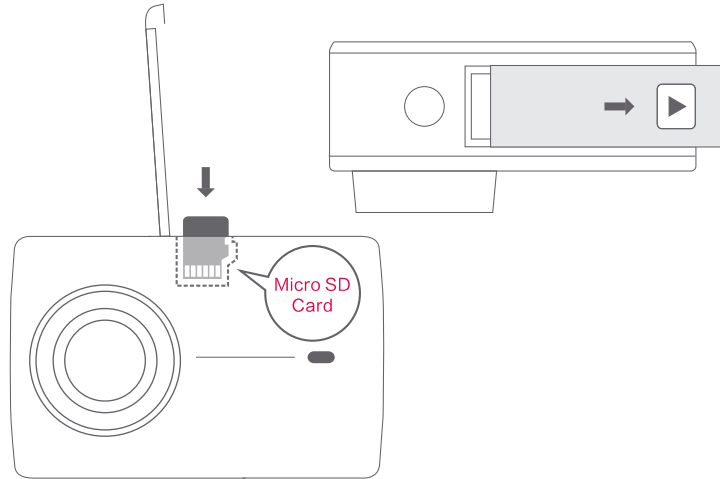
Open the battery cover: Press the arrow key, then pull following the arrow direction.

To insert Micro SD card:

- Slide card into card slot with the label facing the front of the battery.The card will click into place when fully inserted.

To remove Micro SD card:

- Press fingernail against edge of card and lightly push further into camera. Card will spring out to be removed.



Tip: We recommend micro SD card at www.yitechnology.com to ensure high-quality 4K Video.

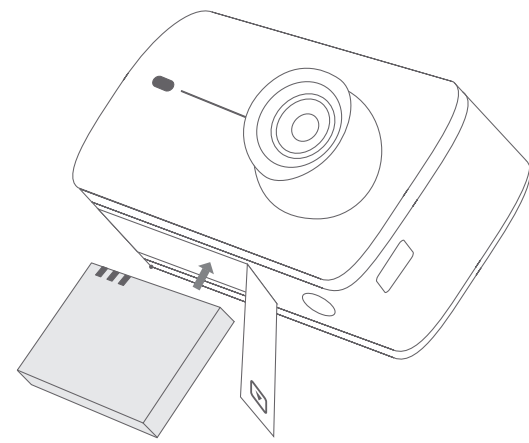
4.Insert/Remove battery

To insert the battery:

- Open the battery cover by following step 3 above;
- Insert the battery in the battery slot following the arrow direction;
- Close the battery cover and confirm the door is closed firmly.

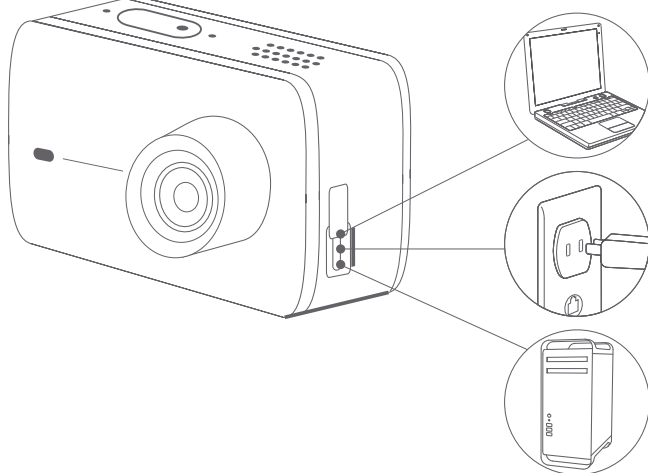
To remove the battery :

- Open the battery cover by following step 3 above;
- Grasp the battery pull-tab and remove from the battery slot.

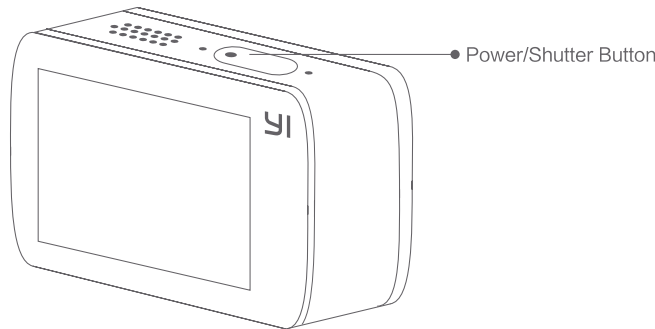


5.Battery charging

- Connect the camera to a power source or computer with the Micro USB cable.
 - The camera must be powered off while charging using a computer;
 - The red status light remains ON while the battery is charging;
 - The red status light will turn OFF when the battery is fully charged.



6.How to use the camera



1) Powering on and off:

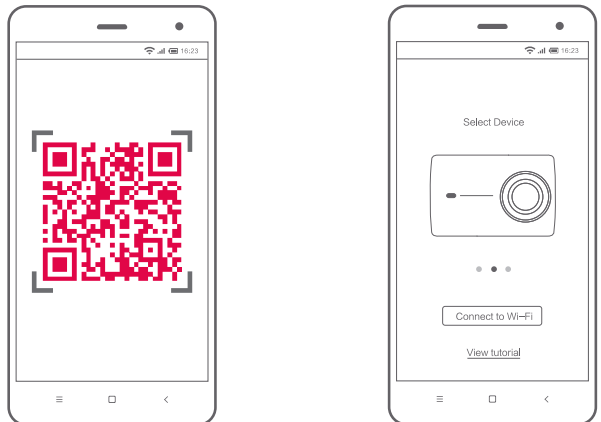
To power on: Press the Power/Shutter Button. The screen will turn on and there will be a sound.

To power off: Long press the Power/Shutter Button.The screen will turn black and there will be a sound.

Tip: Follow the quick interface introduction when you power on the camera the first time.

2)Connect to YI Action Camera App

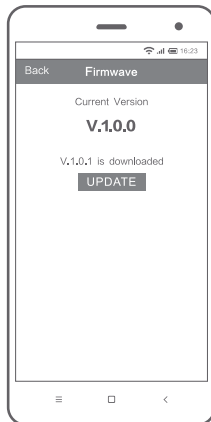
Scan the following QR code to download YI Action Camera App and install the app on your smartphone or tablet.
Or, you can find the App on the App Store® or Google Play store by searching for YI Action.
Open the YI Action Camera App. The connection interface as shown in the figure below. View the tutorial, using APP to connect the camera.



Tip: Control settings and mode or transfer files from your camera to your phone.

3) Firmware update

The most current camera firmware will be downloaded automatically after you finish your first connection with your smartphone and camera. For the best performance, please use the most updated version.
Update from the App: Make sure the camera is connected to a power source or has more than 50% battery life.



4) Transferring files

- Connect the camera to the computer using the USB cable to transfer photo and video files to the computer.
- Copy files to the computer or external hard drive.

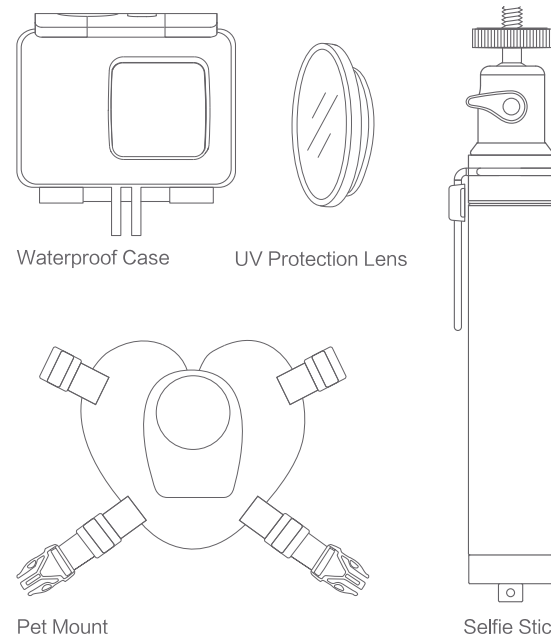
