INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Thank you for using KobaGuard safe box
Please read this manual first

1. SECURITY WARNINGS

- 1.1. Never put the mechanical key inside the safe box.
- 1.2. Do not use the mechanical key to open the safe regularly.
- 1.3. Always change the code with the door open and check the new code 3-4 times before closing.
- 1.4. It is strongly recommended to change the factory default code before using your new safe.

2. MAIN FEATURES

- 2.1. Solid arc welded heavy gauge steel construction.
- 2.2. 18mm solid steel bolts for maximum security and durability.
- 2.3. Powered by 4 x AA 1.5V batteries. Automatic low battery warning.
- 2.4. Digital display screen.
- 2.5. Internal carpet.
- 2.6. Rear and bottom mounting holes.
- 2.7. 3-6 digit guest code and 6 digit master code.
- 2.8. 5 minute system freeze on incorrect code entry (4 times).
- 2.9. Mechanical key override.

3. LOCK THE SAFE

- Enter any 3-6 digit code, then press the "LOCK(#)" key.
- "CLOSED" will appear on the digital display, indicating that the safe is locked.



4. OPEN THE SAFE

- 4.1. Opening by personal code:
 - Enter your 3-6 digit code.
 - "OPENED" appears on the digital display and the safe is opened.



4.2. Opening by master code:

- Press the "LOCK"(#) button twice,
- "SUPER" appears on the digital display,
- Enter the master code (factory setting "000000").
- "OPENED" appears on the digital display and the safe is opened.



4.3 Opening with the mechanical key and resetting the guest code (in case both codes (master and guest) are forgotten):

- Open the security cover: turn it anticlockwise
- Insert the key and turn it clockwise
- The door opens
- While the digital display shows "OPEN", enter the new 3-6 digit code and press the "LOCK(#)" button.
- Remove the key
