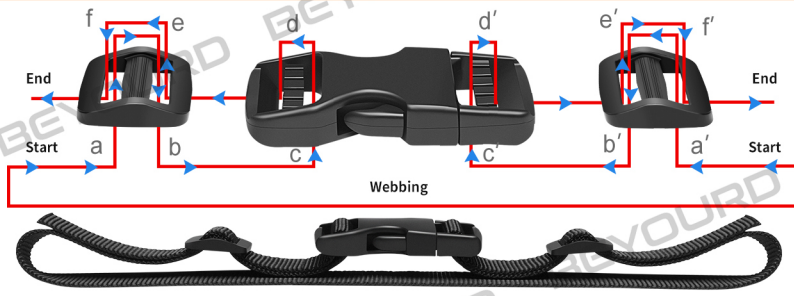


# Thickened Strap and Buckle Kit Assembly Instructions

## Overall Assembly Method Chart



### Warm Tips

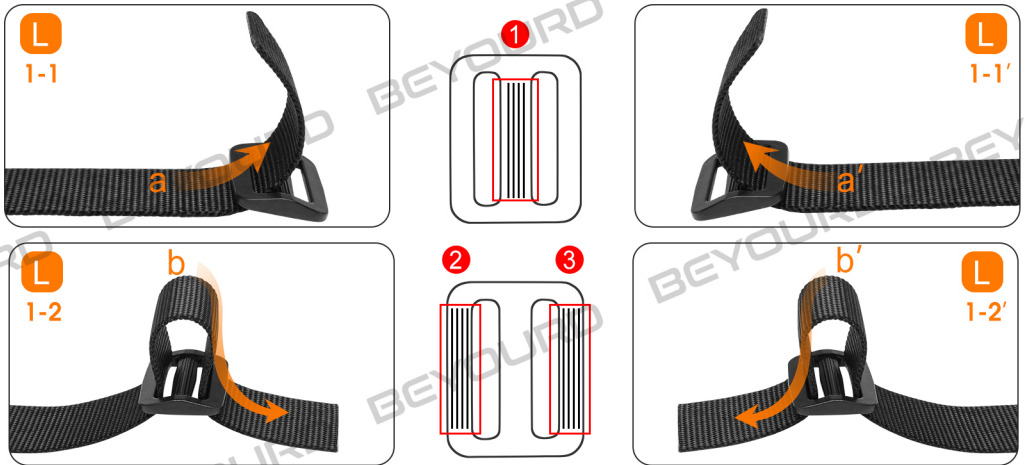
A. To prevent the ends of the webbing from fraying due to its woven structure, lightly singe the edges with a lighter after cutting.

B. When cutting the webbing to your desired length, it is advisable to include approximately 4 inches of extra webbing. This ensures that you can thread it through the tri-glide buckle, then through the side release buckle, and back through the tri-glide buckle again, leaving about 1 inch of webbing to secure it firmly.

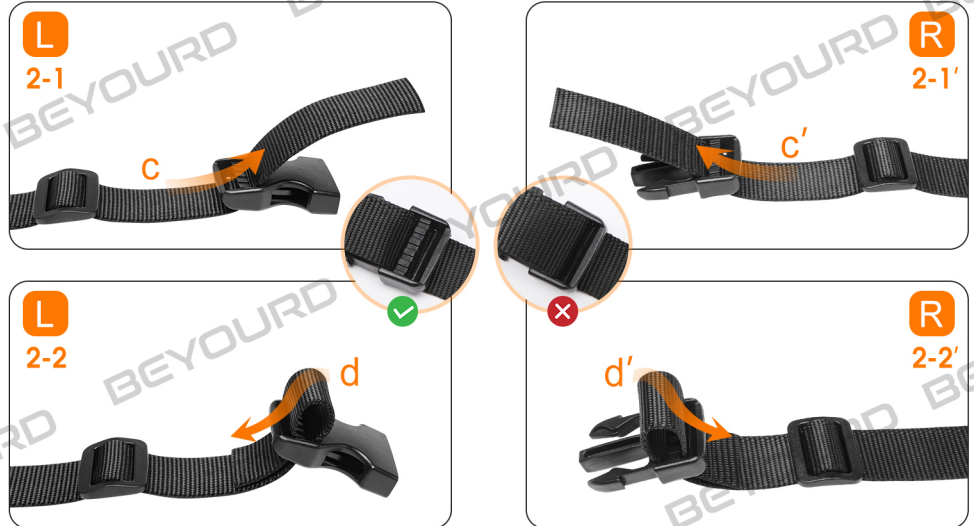
The installation diagram featured here uses a 1-inch strap and buckle kit as an example.

Buckle kits of other sizes are installed using the same method, allowing for customization to suit your specific requirements.

## Step-by-Step Assembly Instructions



Guide the webbing through the three marked contact points to ensure a secure fit.



This assembly technique is a primary method for setting up your strap. However, remember that the webbing and buckle can be utilized in a multitude of different ways across various scenarios.
