



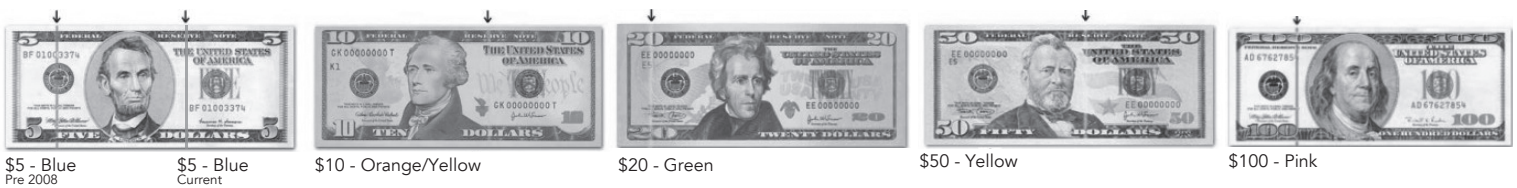
The UV Pro is a powerful ultraviolet light which is an excellent tool for detecting counterfeit US paper currency. Install near the register to check bills which are suspect.

CAUTION: DO NOT LOOK DIRECTLY AT UV LIGHT. PROLONGED EXPOSURE CAN CAUSE EYE DAMAGE. PLEASE KEEP AWAY FROM CHILDREN. THIS IS NOT A TOY.

Holder Installation: Your UV Pro comes with a holder and coil tether. Clean and dry the desired installation surface. Peel the paper off of the adhesive pad, and press firmly into place. Note that the widest part of the cup must be facing upward. Also note that the adhesive pad works best on smooth clean surfaces.

Battery Installation: The UV Pro uses 3 AAA batteries. Unscrew the back of the unit and slide out the battery sleeve. Note that the negative (flat) end of the batteries should rest on the springs. Batteries should be replaced when the UV lights begins to dim. To prolong battery life, and also to prolong the effectiveness of the UV LEDs, it's important to turn the light off after each use.

Operation and Directions for Use: Click the button on the back of the UV Pro to activate the UV light. Shine the light onto the bill to reveal the glowing plastic strip located in all US paper money denominations \$5.00 and up. The denomination of the bill is micro-printed on the strip. Use the chart below for the location and color of the strip for each denomination. **Remember, if you cannot find the strip, or if the strip is the wrong color, or in the wrong place, the bill is probably counterfeit!**



Currency Guide Sticker: Use the enclosed currency guide sticker to help you locate the UV security stripe. Line the bill up with the left side of the sticker and shine the UV Pro on the money. The guide shows you where the stripe is located, and illustrates the correct color.

Important! On older \$100 bills the pink strip may be very difficult to see. For these bills, hold the light on the back of the bill just to the left of Franklin's portrait. This should reveal the strip clearly. The strip may also be faint on older \$10 bills, where the yellow strip is located to the right of Jefferson's portrait. In this case shine the light through the back of the bill to locate the strip.
