

2FT and 3FT Mosaic Balloon Frame - Pre Cut Letters and Shapes

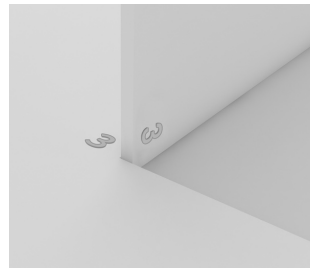
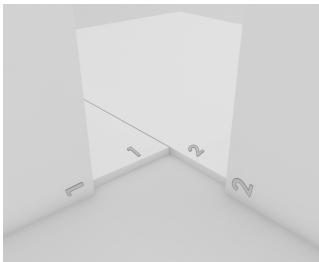

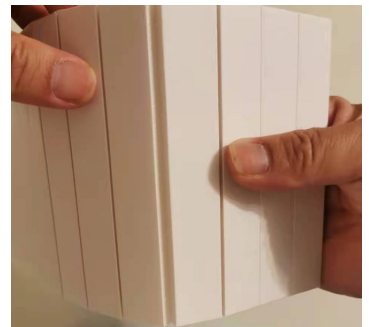


How To Assemble Mosaic Balloon Letter or Shape Frame

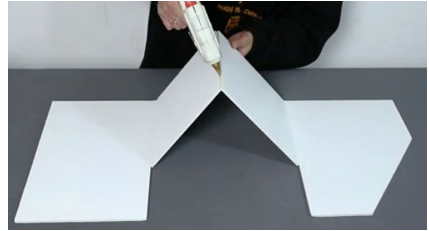
Step 1: Unfold and lay out the bottom base on a flat surface. Next, match the side walls to the bottom base by the corresponding numbered labels. **DON'T use double-sided tape or hot glue yet. Ensure everything match up, no missing pieces or damage boards.**



Step 2: Your side walls may be one of the followings: 1) straight walls, 2) walls with scored lines, or 3) a combination of both. If you have scored lines side walls, press gently on the foam board to open the scored lines so it becomes a bendable side walls.



Step 3: Once you have matched all the side walls to the bottom base, then apply hot glue to seal up all the scored lines on the base so it becomes strong, sturdy and no bendable parts.



Step 4: Use double sided tape to tape along the edge of the entire bottom base. Then match and stick the side walls to the base using the numbered label. **BE CAREFUL - tape is strong and sticky.**

Step 5: Repeat Step 4 until all of the side walls surrounding the base are securely attached. To ensure maximum stability, apply hot glue along the inner seam and edges (the line between the base and the side walls and edges).



Seal up any gaps you have so the item is strong, stable and sturdy.

How to fill balloon frame

Step 1: Lay your item on a flat surface to make it easier to add balloons.

Step 2: Inflate balloons to the desired size. An electric pump can speed up the process. To achieve a beautiful mosaic effect, it's recommended that you use various sizes balloon.

Step 3: First, place the larger balloons inside the frame and attach them to the foam board using the balloon glue dots. Keep adding balloons until the frame is full. You can put glue dots between balloons to keep them together inside the frame.

Step 4: After filling all of the larger balloons, add smaller balloons around them to create a mosaic-like appearance for your frame.

Q: Can I use the mosaic balloon letter for outdoor events?

A: It is not suggested to be used for outdoor events. They are more ideal for indoor use due to their light weight. However, if you choose to use them outdoor, put the items on concrete ground or pavement.

Q: Should I set up a few days before my event?

A: Yes, we suggest setting up several days before the event. If there're problems, reach out to us so we can help you.

Q: How can I set up my mosaic balloon letter correctly?

A: Please read our instruction sheet or watch the instruction video BEFORE assembling.

Q: How to keep frame stable?

A: 2FT Mosaic Balloon frame comes with stabilizer base board, glue that base board to the bottom of the letter to help it stand up. Most of the 3FT letters can stand on its own, we do include bottom base board for a few letter (e.g. Letter P and F). Please refer to pictures below.
