(2) If you are using a dual Wi-Fi router, and it broadcast 2 Wi-Fi signals, make sure that your phone was connected with the 2.4GHz Wi-Fi signal.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2</p>	<p>(3) If you are using a dual Wi-Fi router but it broadcast only 1 Wi-Fi signal, you will have to manage your Wi-Fi router and change the setting to have 2.4GHz Wi-Fi.</p> <p><b>Method 1: Automatically add equipment</b></p> <p>Turn on the Bluetooth function of your phone. The Smart Plug connected with Cloud Intelligence App</li> <li>3. Cloud Intelligence App user ID and password</li> </ol> <p>There are two ways to connect the cloud intelligence app to Alexa. One way is through cloud intelligence app to select -More Services-works with the Google Assistant-Bind Account- to link.
