Power On

Auto Power On:
Take out the earphones from the charging case, they will power on automatically with a beep: pairing.

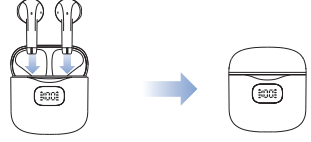


Manual Power On:
When the device is not connected, press the left or right earphone for 3-5 seconds. The indicator blinks red and blue alternately and prompts "power on"

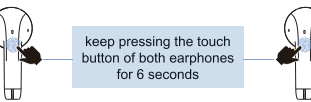


Power Off

Auto Power Off:
Put the earphones into the charging case, they will power off automatically.

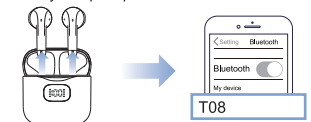


Manual Power Off:
When the device is not connected, press the left or right earphone for 6 seconds and the indicator flashes red and blue alternately, then the indicator goes off and prompts " power off " .

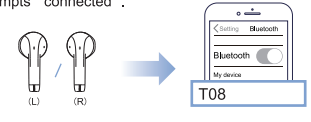


Pairing

Stereo Mode:
1. Open the charging case and take the earphones out of the case, the two earphones will automatically turn on and connect to each other. The master earphone's indicator blinks red and blue alternately to wait to be paired.
2. Turn on your phone's Bluetooth, search for " T08 " and select it. The earphones connect with your phone successfully and prompts " connected " .

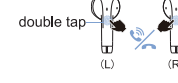


Single Earbud Mode:
1. Take an earphone (left/right) out of the charging case.
2. Turn on your phone's Bluetooth and select " T08 ". The earphone connect with your phone successfully and prompts " connected " .

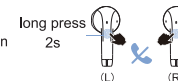


Phone Calls Control

Answer/ End Calls:
Double tap the touch button of Right or Left earphone.

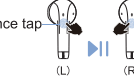


Reject Calls:
Long press 2s the touch button of Right or Left earphone.



Music

Play/Pause:
Once tap the touch button of Right or Left earphone.



Next Track:
Double tap the touch button of Right earphone.



Previous Track:
Double tap the touch button of Left earphone.



Volume Up:
Long press the touch button of Right earphone.

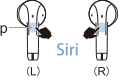


Volume Down:
Long press the touch button of Left earphone.



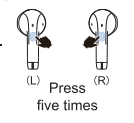
Active Siri

Active Siri:
Triple tap the touch button of Right or Left earphone. (when the music is paused)

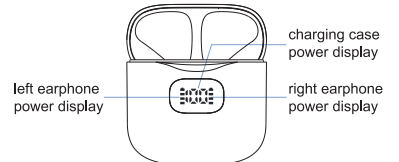


Reset Earbuds

Reset earphones:
1. In the state of power on without any device connected, quickly tap the Left or Right earphone 5 times, then earphones will power off with a voice prompt " Power off " .
2. Delete " T08 " record on your phone and deactivate the bluetooth setting.
3. Put the earphones back into the charging case.
4. Wait for 10s to open the charging case and turn on the bluetooth of your phone. Click "T08" to connect, earphones will work properly.



Charging

Digital Charging Display:


Earphones Charging:
Put the earphones into the charging case and close the case. The earphone light will remain red for 10 seconds and then go out.

Charging for the Case:
When the battery level of the charging case falls below 20%, open the lid and the display will light up to show the battery level. The earphone light will blink for 10 seconds and then go out.
Use the type-c charging cable (provided) to connect your computer (with power on) or an adapter (not provided) to your charging case. The charging case power display will be 100% after fully charged.

Q&A

If you are unable to connect your Bluetooth earphones to your computer or tablet, you can do the following:

1. Make sure your computer's Bluetooth is turned on: If not, turn on Bluetooth and reconnect the earphones.
2. Restart the computer: Please try to restart the computer, and then try to connect the earphones again.
3. Update your computer's Bluetooth driver: If your computer's Bluetooth driver is out of date, this may cause connection problems. Check the manufacturer's website for the latest drivers and install them.
4. Try to connect to another device: If you have another device that can connect to the earphones, such as a smartphone or tablet, try to connect to see if there is a problem with the earphones or computer.
5. Reset the earphones.

Bluetooth earphones can sometimes have trouble connecting to devices. This may be due to interference from other wireless devices, low battery or outdated software. There are several things you can try to improve this situation:

1. Reboot the earphones and the device to be connected.

2. Make sure your earphones are fully charged and in pairing mode, and that your earphones are not automatically connected to another device.
3. Disable any other Bluetooth devices that may interfere with the connection or change the usage environment.
4. Check your device for any software updates and install them when available.

The audio quality of Bluetooth earphones may deteriorate over time with use. There may be several reasons for this problem:

1. Low battery: Audio quality may be degraded when the earphones' battery are low. This is because when the battery is low, the earphones cannot transmit or receive signals effectively.
2. Interference: Bluetooth earphones use radio waves to transmit audio signals. If there are other electronic devices nearby that also use radio waves, such as a Wi-fi router or microwave, they may cause interference and degrade audio quality.
3. Physical damage: If the earphones get wet, the internal components may be damaged, which can affect the audio quality.
4. Connection problems: Sometimes the Bluetooth connection between the earphones and the paired device can become unstable over time. This can cause audio interruptions or sound distortion.

If you are often accidentally pressing the button on your wireless earphones when you try to adjust them, there are a few things you can do to try to avoid accidentally touching the button:

1. Use a different grip- try adjusting your earphones with a different grip. If you are using your fingers to adjust them , try using your thumb instead, or vice versa. This might help you avoid accidentally touching the button.
2. Practice adjusting them- spend some time practicing adjusting your earphones so that you can do it without looking at them. This will help you avoid accidentally touching the button because you' be more aware of where it is.

To improve the audio quality of Bluetooth earphones, try the following:

Charge the earphones fully before using them.

Clean the charging contacts , and mesh of ear tips with an alcohol pad to remove dust or earwax that might be affecting charging or sound volume.

Keep the earphones away from other electronic devices that use radio waves.

Avoid exposing the earphones to moisture.

If the charging case is not charging the earphones: Make sure your case is fully charged.

Make sure the earbuds are properly plugged in or the case has enough battery to charge the earphones.

Check the charging ports on both the earphones and the charging case for any debris or damage. Clean the ports with a soft , dry cloth if necessary.

If you're having trouble charging the case, you can try these methods below:

Make sure the charging cable you are using is compatible with the charging case and is not damaged, if the cable is damaged, try using a different charging cable.

Check the charging case and the charging port on the cable for debris or damage. If necessary, clean the ports with a soft, dry cloth.

Try using a different power source, such as a different USB port or wall adapter for charging. If the charging case does not use one power source for charging, it can use another power source.

We recommend that you use a 5v adapter to avoid damaging the battery.
