1. Instructions



01 Design and cut



02 Weed



03 Peel Transfer Tape away



04 Apply Transfer Tape and burnish

① For better adhesion of the cut pattern, use a burnishing tool such as a Scraper



05 Done

2. Recommended Settings

Silhouette Cameo 4	Material:Vinyl Matte Blade:3 Force:6 Speed:5 Passes:2

Tip:Cut quality may vary depending on machine age and the degree of blade wear. Please ensure the blade is sharp and free of debris before cutting, and conduct a test cut with the recommended settings

3. Notice

- 01. The material is not suitable for inkjet, laser, or thermal printers
- 02. Cutting patterns with a line width under 2 mm is not recommended
- 03. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight

4. Useful Tips

- 4.1 How to Weed Quickly?
- 01. Weed in a well-lit environment
- 02. For best results, weed directly on the cutting pad after cutting
- 03. Start by removing larger excess manually, before using a weeder for finer details. Gently press down on unweeded areas to prevent lifting the pattern edges
- 4.2 How to Enhance Adhesion?
- 01. To ensure firm adhesion, apply the cut pattern to a clean, dry, smooth, and texture-free surface.
- 02. Wait 24 hours before washing the item to which the vinyl is applied.
